Learning Success Program Requirements and Fees

Requirements:

Families seeking additional academic support at Crean Lutheran High School are asked to complete the following steps:

1. Submit a written request for additional support to the Learning Success Program Director.
2. Submit a psychoeducational evaluation report.
3. Submit supporting educational documents.
 - Current school year report cards
 - Historical report cards (minimum-last year's report cards)
 - Current IEP; if applicable
 - Other evaluation reports (Occupational Therapy, Speech and Language etc.)
4. Schedule an appointment with the Learning Success Program Director.

Recommendation for enrollment in the Learning Success Program is based on items outlined in our Parent/Student Handbook.

Program Fee Structure: Crean Lutheran High School offers competitive services and pricing for its comprehensive Learning Success Program. Costs are specifically earmarked to ensure appropriate staffing, tools, and services are available to successfully accommodate students, as described above.

- LSP Lab class: as determined through the assessment process- \$1,750.00 annually (non-refundable)
- LSP students not enrolled in lab- \$275.00 annually (non-refundable)

LSP Lab is strongly recommended for all LSP students. CLHS will partner with parents in determining whether or not LSP Lab is required.
