

# HGHS Summer Driver's Education Program

## 2018 Summer Sessions

Session I -May 29-June 13

Session II -June 14-29

On behalf of Madison County Schools, we are glad to be hosting the **2018 Summer Driver's Education Program** at Hazel Green High School. The class is made up of two sections: classroom instruction and actual driving experience. Students will be required to attend all five days of classroom instruction and a minimum of three consecutive days of scheduled driving times. At the conclusion of the classroom instruction, each student will drive a minimum of three consecutive days as assigned (1.5 hours per day). Driving groups will be determined by the instructor on the first day of each session. The students are only required to be on campus during their 1.5 hour driving/riding time once that portion begins.

### **SPACE IS LIMITED AND SEATS WILL BE FILLED ON A FIRST COME BASIS.**

- Registration will be done through [myschoolfees.com](http://myschoolfees.com). When you submit payment, your space will be reserved. Space is limited to the first 24 students to submit payment on [myschoolfees.com](http://myschoolfees.com)
  - Fee: \$120 for students attending Madison County Schools, \$145 for out of district students.
  - The following items are required on the first day of class. Students who fail to submit these on the first day of class will be dismissed without refund or credit.
1. Copy of driving permit if applicable. Students must be 15 years of age or older and eligible to obtain an Alabama Learner License. Students who do not have a Driver's Permit will be asked to provide results of an eye exam.
  2. Complete [third-party parent permission form](#) to allow student to participate in third- party testing and attempt to earn a boating certificate.

## General Information

- **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED ONCE CLASSES HAVE BEGUN**
- **Course 290001 Driver and Safety Traffic Education:** This course includes safe driving theory; in class study; driving hazards; boating safety; behind-the-wheel experience; and safety practices. (Although it is recommended, students are not required to have a Driver's Permit to take this course; however, they must be 15 years of age or older and eligible to obtain an Alabama Learner License. Students who do not have a Driver's Permit will be asked to provide results of an eye exam.)
- Madison County Code of Conduct will be in effect during the summer program. All discipline issues are subject to dismissal with loss of credit and forfeiture of fees.
- No credit will be awarded to any student missing more than one day of instruction, regardless of the reason. Check-outs and tardies count as missed time. Students who exceed this time will be dismissed without refund or credit. No make-up hours will be scheduled. Any student dismissed for disciplinary reasons will also be dismissed without refund or credit.
- Student driving time is based on time needed to demonstrate a proficiency of skills.
- Students will be given the opportunity to take their Alabama license test if no class time is missed.
- Students must bring their lunch, including drink, on days they are in the classroom. Vending machines will be available.
