A Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees of Kilgore ISD was held Monday, September 25, 2017, beginning at 6:00 PM in the KISD Administration Building, 301 N. Kilgore St., Kilgore, TX 75662.

President Dereck Borders called the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m. and announced the presence of a quorum.
