Water Treatment Operators operate, inspect, and maintain complex processes and equipment in water treatment systems. They are responsible for treating drinking water to meet state and federal standards before it is delivered to consumers.

This 54-hour course covers the fundamental principles involved in water treatment plant operation. The course covers the sources of water, reservoir management, intake structures, drinking water regulations, fluoridation, instrumentation and lab procedures. There will be an emphasis of the operation and maintenance



safety. This course is designed to prepare the student to take the State of California **Water Treatment Operator** exam. Students will have access to training materials.
