### **Class of 1965 Scholarship with the Cleveland Foundation**

#### **Establishing the Scholarship**

The Class of 1965 scholarship, first awarded in 2011, was established with contributions from 1965 class members and invested with the through the Harvey Alumni Endowment Fund with the Cleveland Foundation. It shall be administered by the Class of 1965 Scholarship Committee in coordination with the Harvey High School's Principal's Scholarship Committee.

#### **Purpose and Award Criteria**

The scholarship is to provide financial support for a graduate of Harvey High School who meets the standards for admission to a four-year academic program in an accredited college or university. The graduate must provide a completed application by April 1st to the guidance office with evidence of:

1. Academic achievement with a grade-point average (G.P.A.) of 3.0 or above.
2. Involvement in school/community activities (athletics, leadership, clubs, music, drama, volunteering, community service).
3. Writing an essay of up to two pages in length outlining the applicant's plans for a college program of studies, reasons for selecting that program, and career goals. The applicant is encouraged to discuss his/her reasons for seeking the award, including financial status and needs.
4. Two letters of recommendation, which may be from Harvey faculty members or guidance counselors, outside work supervisors, volunteer program coordinators, or others who might attest to the student's potential.

#### **Scholarship Details**

1. The number of scholarships given each year will depend on the interest earned with the Cleveland Foundation. The award will be a minimum of \$1500, or more depending on the availability of funds as determined by the Class of 1965 Scholarship Committee.
2. A second-year scholarship of a minimum of \$1000 may be available to the awardee, again depending on the availability of funds. The awardee should contact the Harvey High School Principal's Scholarship Committee by February 1st if interested in renewing the scholarship and submit an application and a transcript of 1<sup>st</sup> semester grades by February 28<sup>th</sup>. 2<sup>nd</sup> year applicants do not need to submit an essay, community and/or community involvement, or recommendations.
3. Deadline to submit applications for current Harvey seniors is April 1<sup>st</sup>. Applications should then be forwarded to the Class of 1965 Scholarship Committee.
4. The Scholarship Committee will select recipients on or before May 1<sup>st</sup>.
5. The scholarship will be awarded by the Alumni Association prior to the beginning of the fall term of the student's freshman year after a copy of the student's acceptance letter to the college and a copy of the student's fall class schedule have been provided to the Alumni Association.

#### **Future Contingencies**

At the time when members of the Class of 1965 Scholarship Committee are all deceased or otherwise unable to carry out their duties, the scholarship program will be administered by the Cleveland Foundation until such time as the Class of 1965 Scholarship Fund is exhausted.



## **HARVEY HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF 1965 SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is designed to assist graduates of Harvey High School with expenses as they pursue post-high school education. Preference will be given to students who demonstrate strong academic performance, financial need, and involvement in school/community activities (athletics, leadership, clubs, drama, volunteering, and community service). Students must have a 3.0 or higher G.P.A. The following application must be submitted by April 1<sup>st</sup>. Students who would like to renew the scholarship for a 2<sup>nd</sup> year must notify the Principal's Scholarship committee by February 1<sup>st</sup> and submit an application with a copy of his/her 1<sup>st</sup> semester transcript of grades by February 28<sup>th</sup>.
