School News

Tuition Approved for the 2017/2018 School Year

The school's budget was presented to the Finance Council at the parish and Father Jack has approved it for the 2017/2018 school year. There will be a 4% tuition increase next year. The breakdown is below.

In-Parish Tuition Rates (calculated over 11 months)

1 Child: \$6,251 / \$568 a month

2 Children: \$11,224 / \$1,020 a month

3 Children: \$14,902 / \$1,355 a month

4 Children: \$17,428 / \$1,584 a month

Out-of-Parish Tuition Rate (calculated over 11 months)

\$9,157 per student / \$832.45 a month

Free Dress For a Week Opened up to All

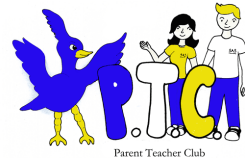
