Meeting Minutes for November 16,, 2017

Members Present: Jeff Becker, Tim Wojcik, Orlando Haltiwanger, Sharon Moore, Michelle Gundlach

- (1) Meeting minutes were reviewed from the meeting on October 19, 2017.
- (2) The committee reviewed the recently released School Report Card. Mr. Becker explained how to read and interpret the data.
 - The two tests taken are SC Ready (ELA and Math) and SC Pass (SS and Science- not taken by 3rd grade). Scores decreased this past year. This was the first time taking it electronically. What role did this take on the lower scores? Question also brought up about whether students think of it more as a game on their laptops? Mr. Becker explained that it is more of a stamina issue.
 - Writing was an overall weakness. Some students treat the essays as short answers. What can be done?
 - Testing window this year is the last 20 days of school, with make-ups going to the last week.
 - A question brought up to do further research on is what was the deviation from the previous few years in test scores. Mr. Becker will pull information for next time.
 - Mr. Becker pointed out staff attendance at 96%, which is very difficult to do.
- (3) Congaree passed its final building inspection, with only a short list of minor things to address. Mr. Becker is hopeful that access to the new classrooms will be next week. The roof is almost completed with about 2 weeks left of work. The gym/cafeteria has become a very versatile facility with many events being held there over the last few weeks. Committee members questioned whether it can be rented out. It is not something pushed but maybe in the future.
- (4) Copies of the Parent Compact have been online for a few weeks and no comments have been made. Paper copies went home on 11/16/17 for parents to read and sign.
- (5) Mr. Becker gave a brief overview of what AdvancEd is and what the school has been doing to prepare for the reaccreditation. Staff members have been working in teams to address the School Quality Factors. AdvancEd is going through an update in their process so Lexington Two is one of the first under the new system. Not much is out there as examples of what is expected. Committee members were given a quality factor summary to review and comment on. Feedback will be sent back to the team leads to address.
- (6) Other - The committee is required to meet 8 times. Currently, there are 9 dates scheduled. Schedule was reviewed and the committee chose to not choose a date to drop yet and to wait until later in the year in case of unforeseen circumstances that prevent the meeting. As of right now, barring any canceled meetings, the May 17, 2017, meeting will be canceled.
