Cost

- No premium
- No deductibles
- \$5 co-pay or \$10 co-pay depending on income level
- No co-pay for verified Native Americans
- All preventive services and immunizations are free of cost

Who Qualifies?

- Children and teens under 19 years old.
- Wyoming residents
- US citizen, qualified non-citizen or lawful permanent resident who has lived in the US for 5 years
- Uninsured for 30 or days or more (with some exceptions)
- Must meet the income eligibility requirements
