Drop-Off and Pick-Up

It is important to keep the traffic flowing during drop-off and pick-up times. Please adhere to these important rules and advise caregivers of them as well:

- Please walk to school whenever possible and use crosswalks.
- Leave plenty of time to park if you walk your child to class (10 minutes). Parking can be very difficult the first month of school.
- The front circle on Morningside Drive is a RED ZONE. It is for drop off and pick up only. You may NEVER leave your vehicle unattended in this area.
- The white zones on Morningside and Francisco are for loading and unloading only during the hours of 8am-9am and 1pm-3pm. There is no parking during those times.
- When picking up in the white zone during drop-off or pick-up, please pull all the way forward to allow other cars to enter behind you.
- There is no drop off in the teacher parking lot off 1st street. It is very dangerous for children riding their bikes.
- Please be courteous to our school neighbors. Do not park in front of driveways or corners.

School Safety

In an effort to provide for a safe and quiet learning environment, all entrance and exit gates will be locked at 8:20am and reopened at 2:40pm. Children must be picked up from school on time each day. We do not provide supervision before or after school. School grounds, including the playground equipment, are off limits to students, caregivers, and siblings until after 3pm every day, including early release Wednesdays. Classes, including P.E., remain in session and it is critical to respect the learning environment. **Please inform caregivers that students must be brought home after dismissal from school and may not linger in any play area.

Quiet Please

While school is in session, we appreciate your help to keep our learning environment quiet. We encourage everyone to use quiet voices and exit the campus quickly.

Visitors

Please do not interrupt a classroom unless expected as a volunteer. Any forgotten lunches or messages should be left at the office. All volunteers must sign-in at the office and wear a Visitor Badge while on campus.
