SUBJECT: MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS

- a) All instrumental music students shall be expected to own or rent their own instrument. This includes the following instruments: flute, clarinet, trumpet, alto saxophone, drum sticks with practice pad and bell set, and trombone
- b) Students will not be required to own or rent the less common and more expensive instruments. Instruments in this category include such instruments as the following: oboe, bassoon, tuba, French horn, baritone horn, tenor and baritone saxophones, School-owned instruments in this classification will be disbursed upon decisions by the instrumental music staff. Decisions will be dependent upon the individual student's talent and merit and the need for a balanced instrumentation at each grade level.
- c) Students and parents/legal guardians will assume responsibility for proper care of school-owned instruments and will pay for damages to same.
- d) The District will only transport, on its vehicles, those instruments meeting certain safety standards as indicated in the New York State Department of Transportation Regulations.
