PROGRAM GOALS:

Beaumont Health System (Beaumont), through its Neuroscience Department, is offering a community-based concussion screening program for student and adult athletes.

Concussion screening is the systematic practice of medically evaluating large, general populations of athletes prior to participation in sports for the purpose of identifying baseline behaviors that may be used at a future date for a comparison post injury. The purpose of the screening is to establish and store a baseline of cognitive function.

SCREENING CONSENT:

I understand that the screening examination and tests offered by Beaumont do not diagnose any neurological or medical conditions and that any sign or symptom found means that my child needs further medical evaluation (full history, physical examination and diagnostic testing) to determine the cause of the sign or symptom. I understand that Beaumont will not provide any further tests or follow-up care without proper consent after this screening. I also understand that it is my responsibility to arrange for my child's follow-up care if indicated and that this screening is not a substitute for a complete pre-activity/athletic competition evaluation by my child's physician.

I understand that the screening will be conducted at school or during team practice and I consent to my child receiving the following screening evaluation:

- Computerized Cognitive Assessment Tool (Tool)
 - My child will answer a series of questions on a computer to determine my child's baseline cognitive function. The Tool is provided by ImPACT Applications and is not designed or intended to be a medical diagnostic study.
 - ImPACT will maintain and store my child's information for concussion management to help health care providers determine your child's baseline in the event of injury. ImPACT also may use my child's information, without identifying information, for research and other business purposes.
 - ImPACT test is not a tool to diagnose concussion. A concussion always should be diagnosed by a qualified health care provider.
 - ImPACT test is not a substitute for medical evaluation and treatment.
