

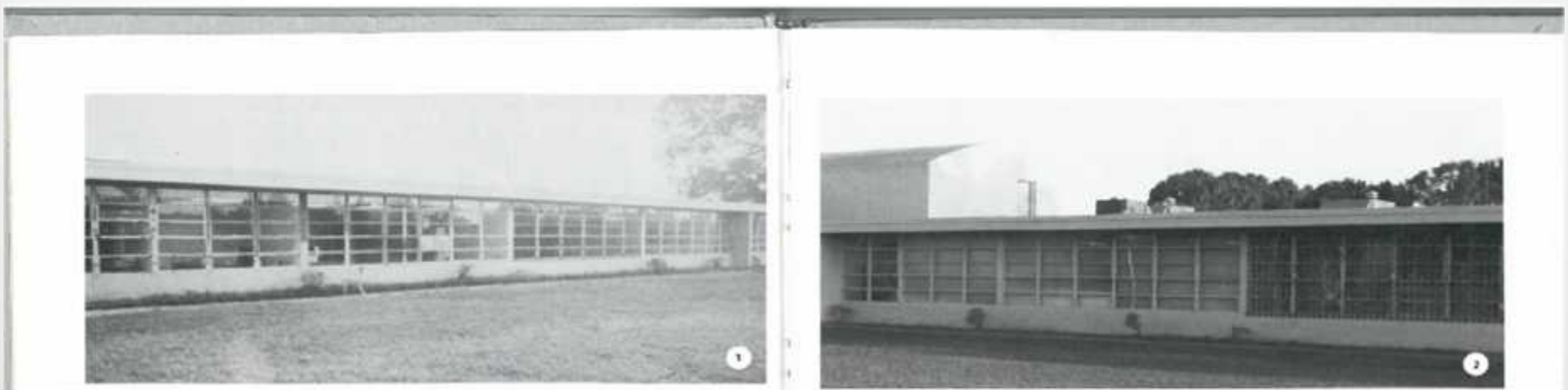

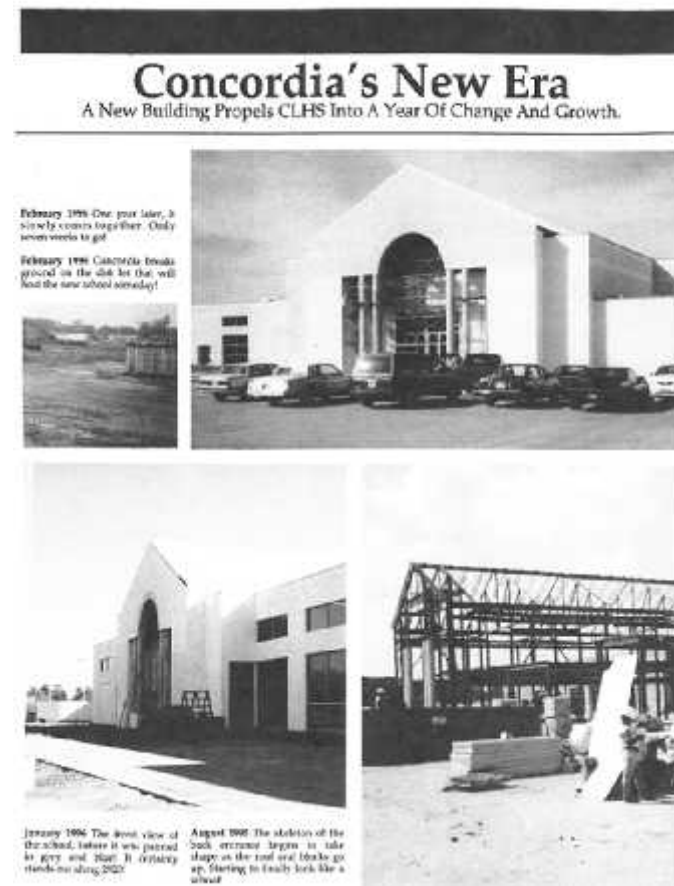

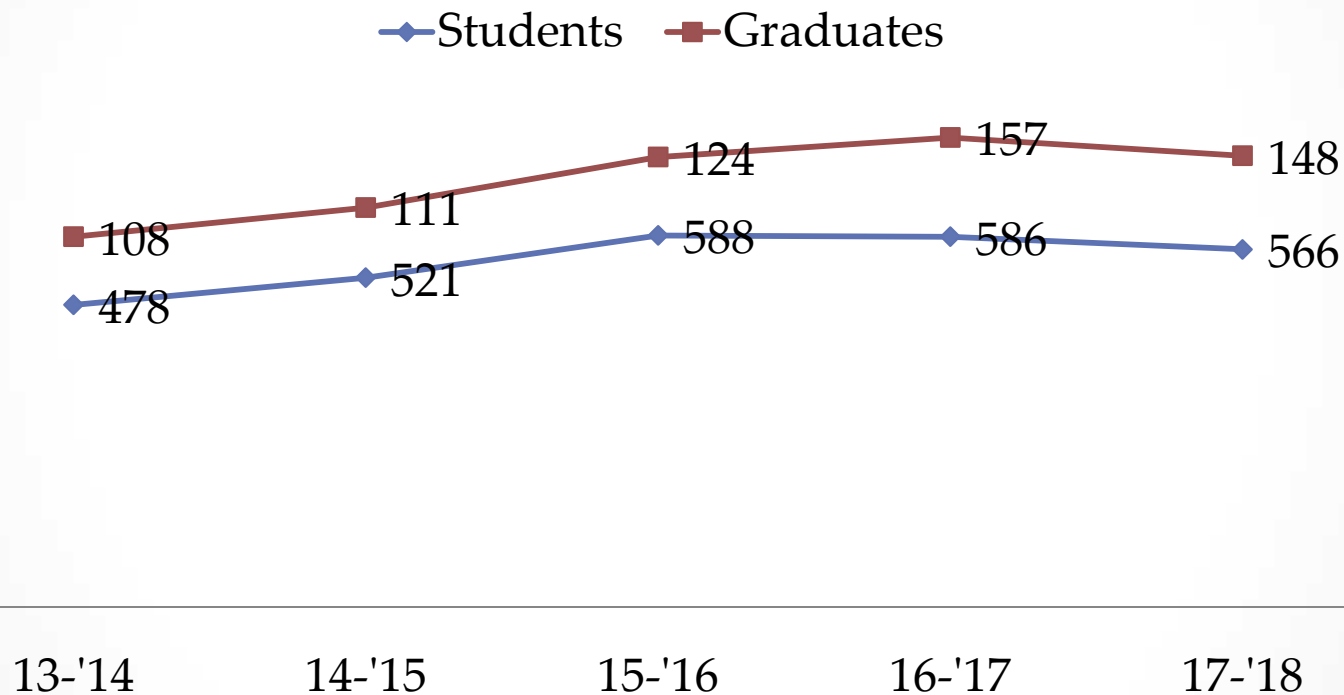

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OUR STUDENTS – CHURCH LIFE

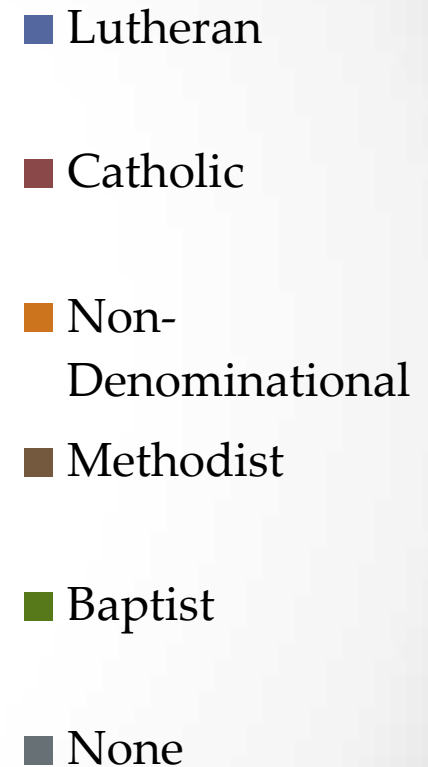
- Concordia has an association of eight Lutheran churches who support the school

- Our students participate in mission and service projects locally and internationally

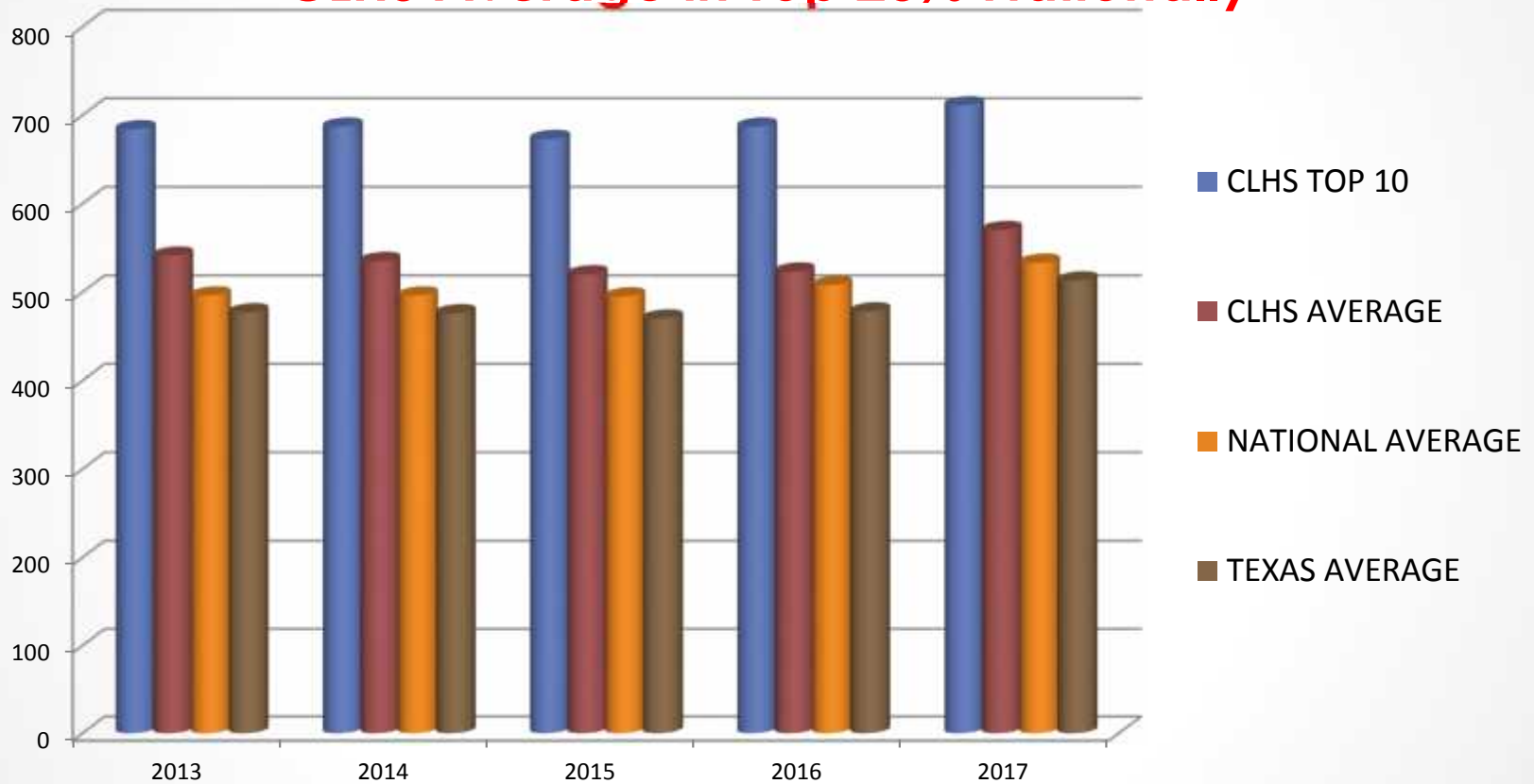

CLHS Average in Top 20% Nationally

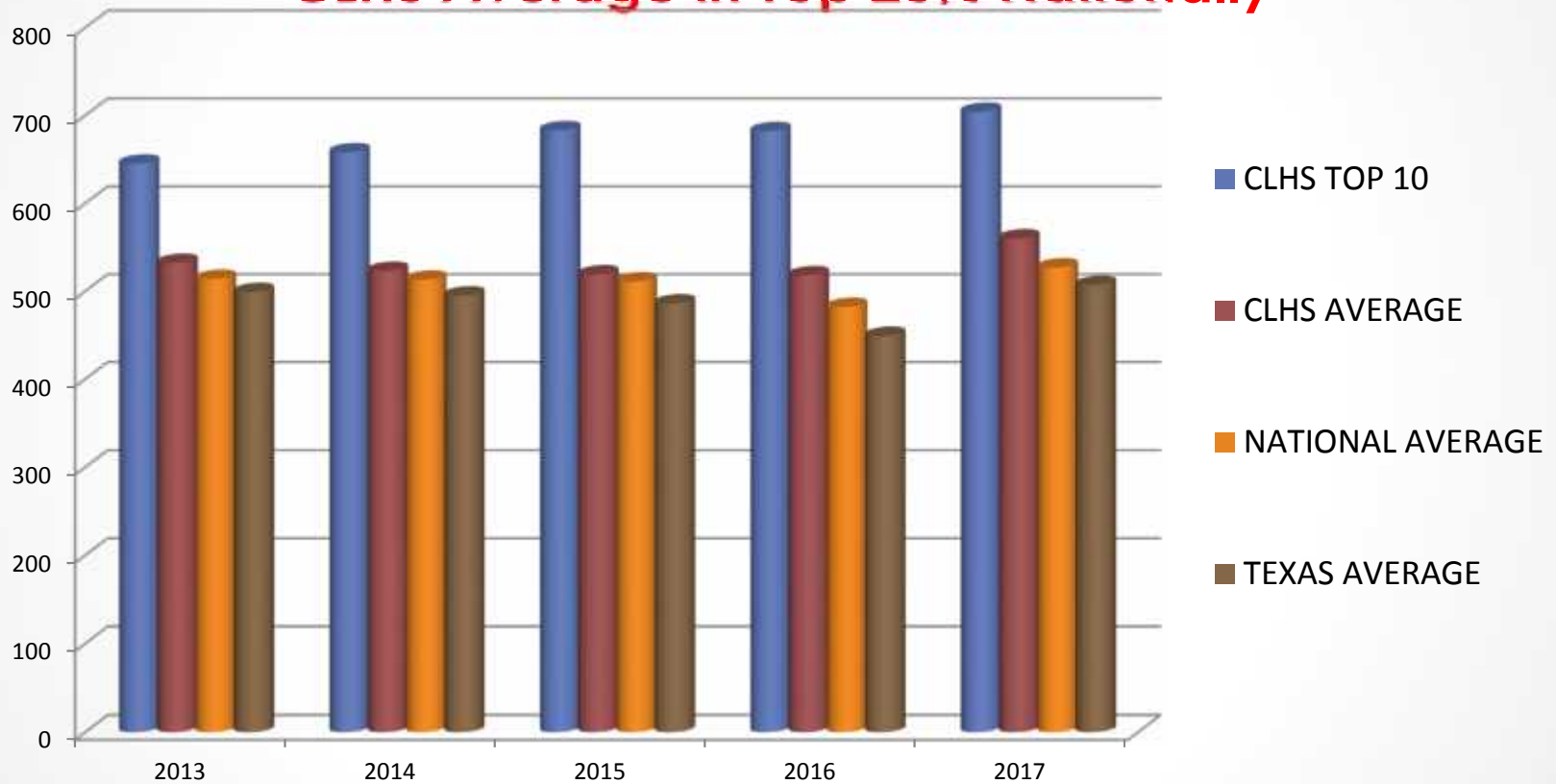

Concordia's top 10 average SAT score= 1391

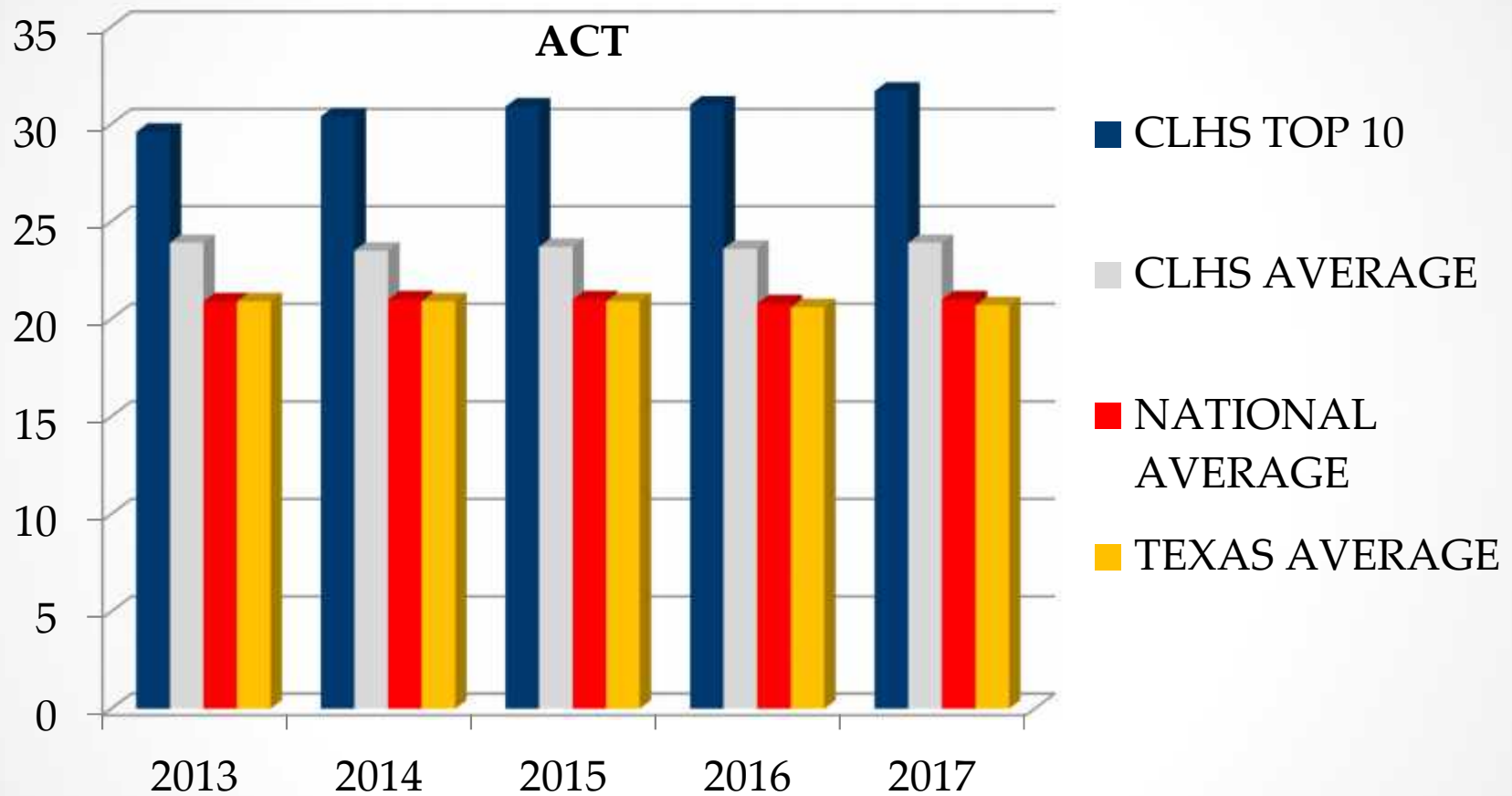
National average= 1060

- Concordia only ranks its top 10% of students

 - Many beyond the top 10% are accepted
- Students have challenging opportunities through Dual Credit and Advanced Placement courses

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ACADEMIC COMPETITION

- Academic Team
 - 2nd place in TAPPS 6A

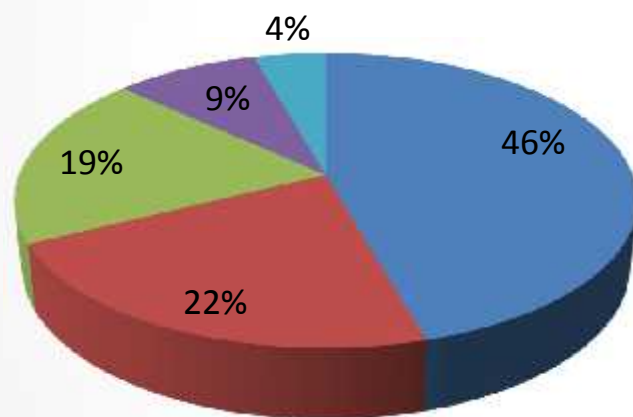


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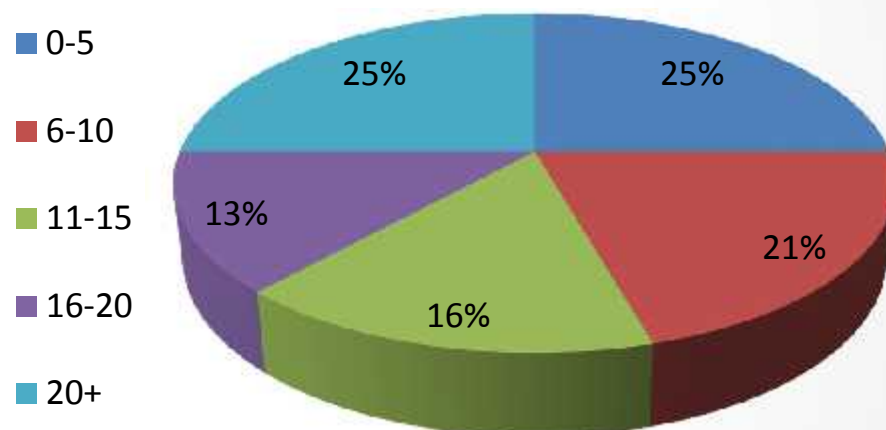

Years in Education

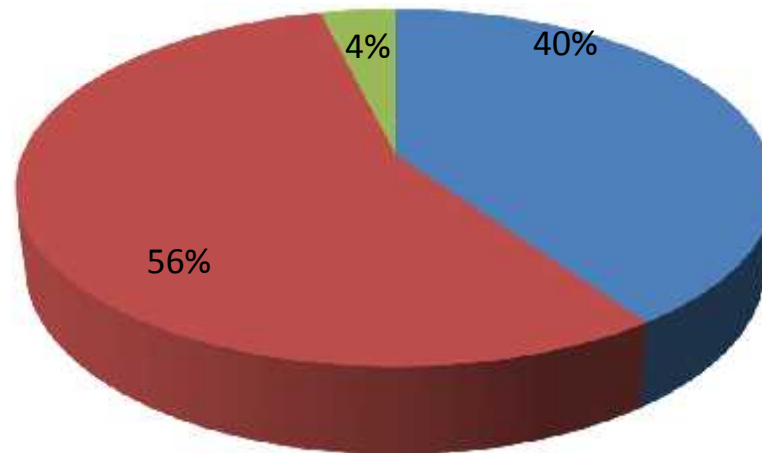

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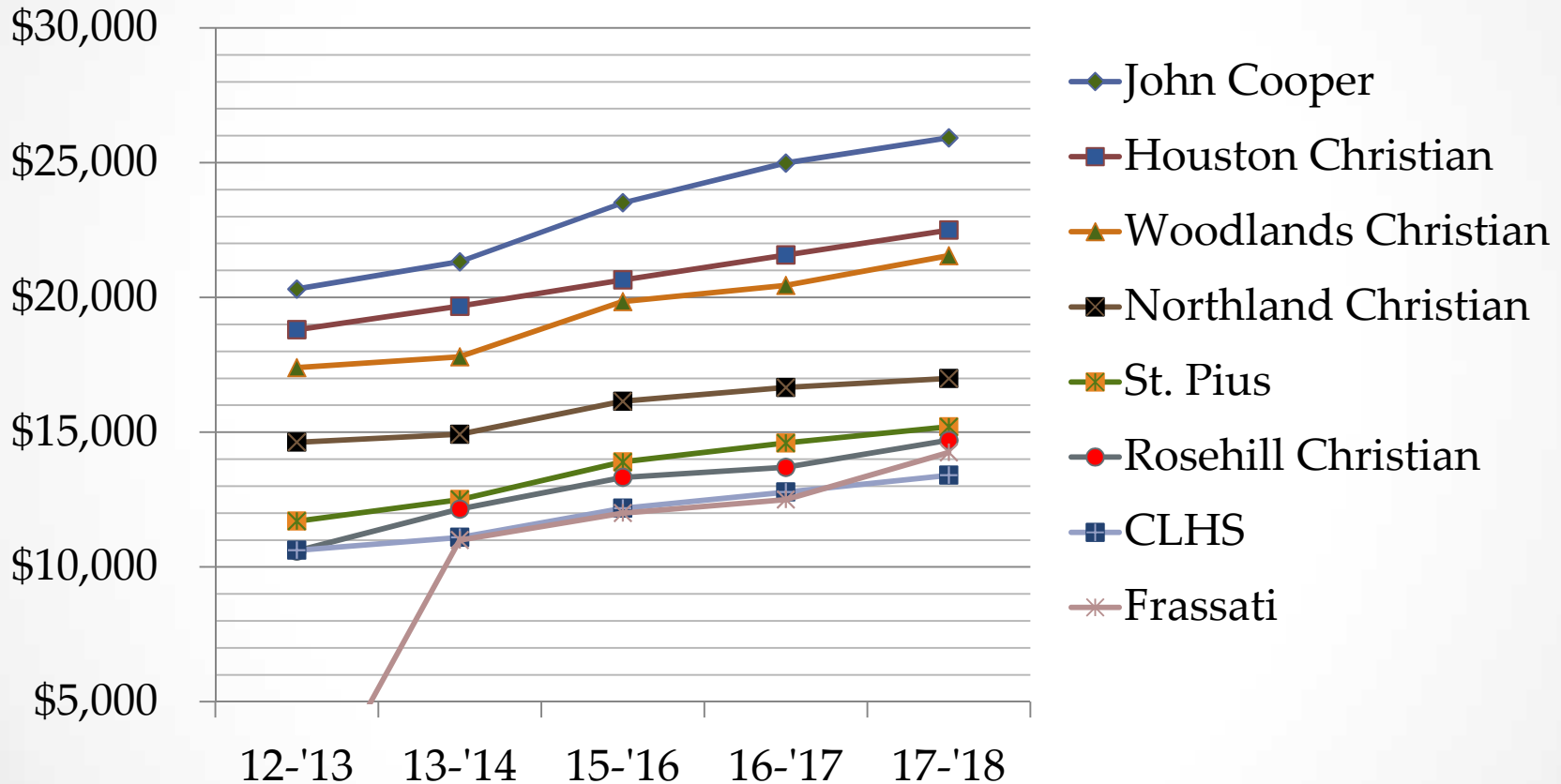

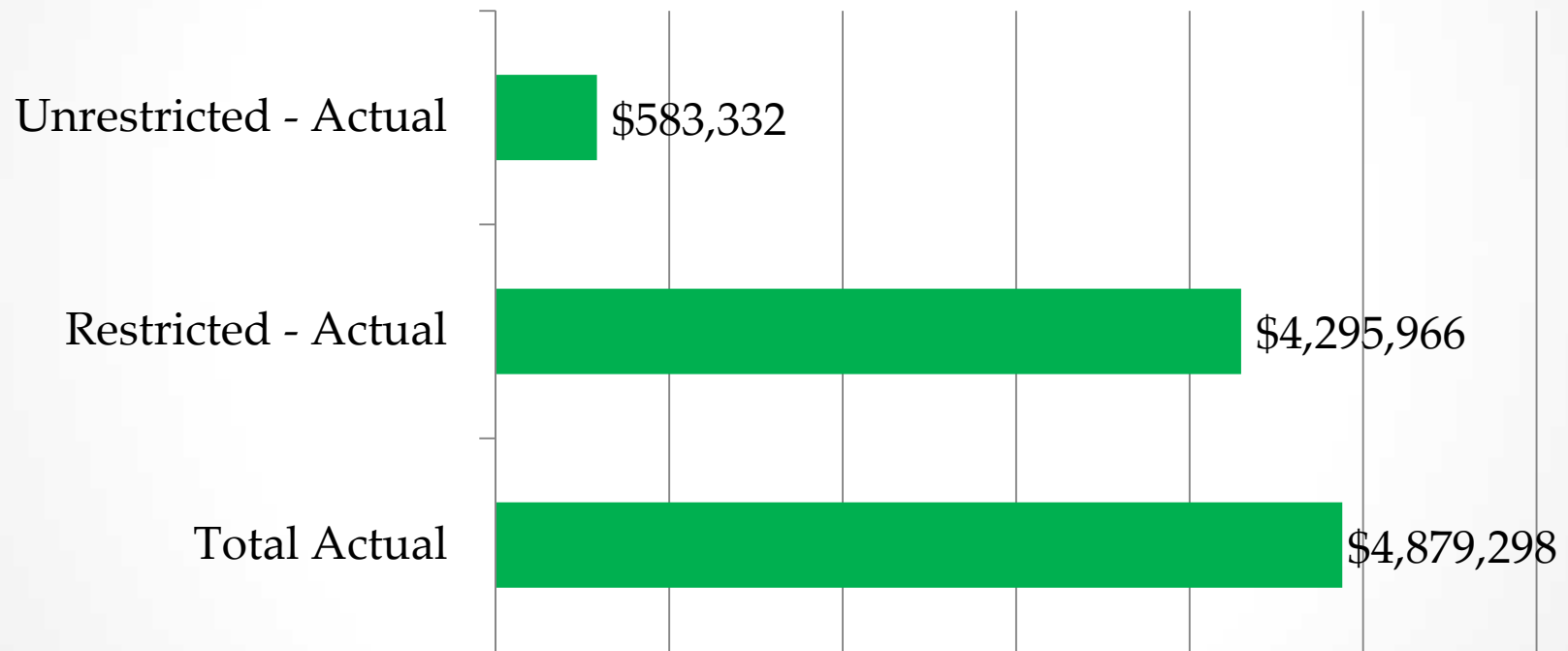


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FINANCIAL SUPPORT

The Capital Campaign is reflected in Restricted giving results.

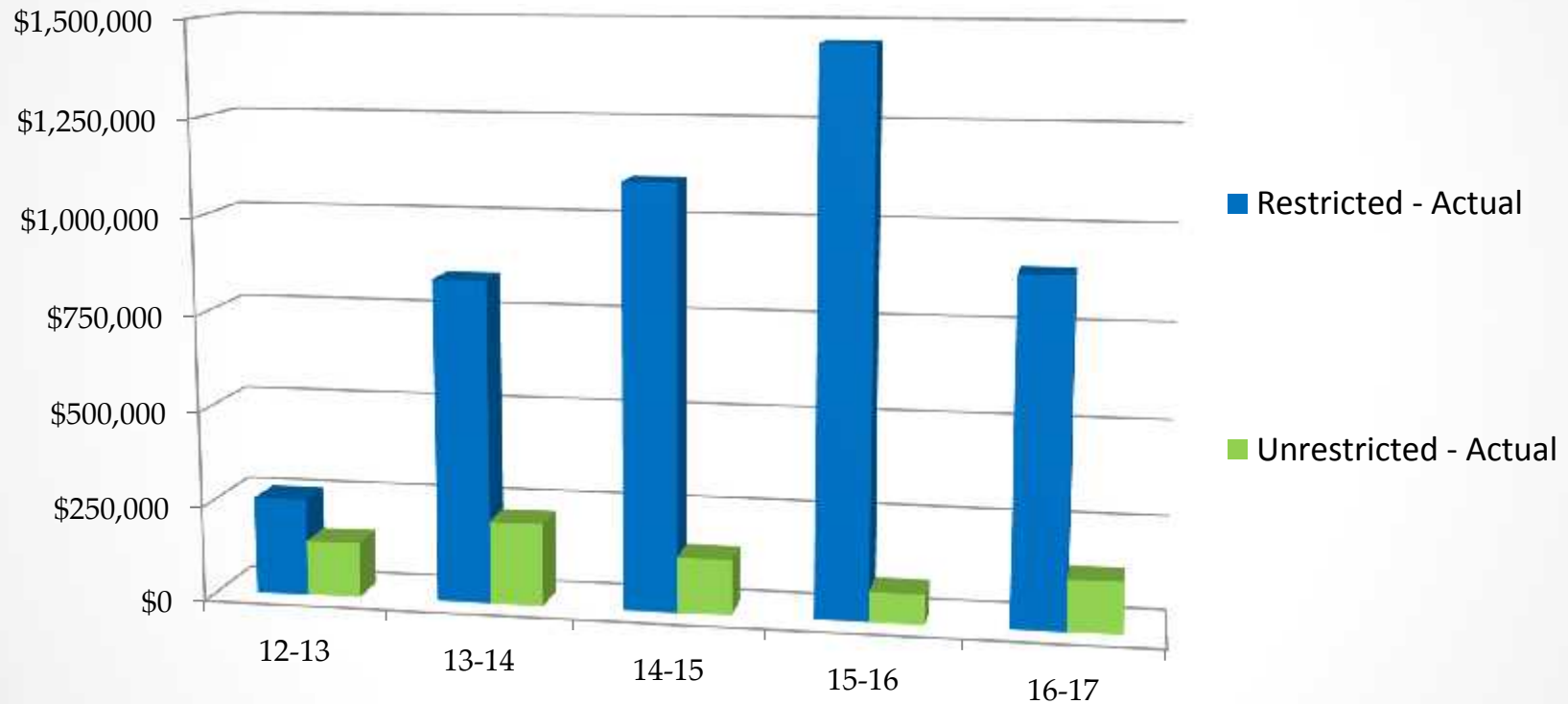
