



# 8th Grade Supply List

\*Note to Parents: We realize that shopping for school supplies can be expensive and time-consuming. In addition to classroom supplies that teachers will purchase, the materials listed below will be used for creative, engaging learning activities throughout the year. We hope you know how much we appreciate your help in purchasing these items! -The 8th Grade Teachers

General Supplies (*unless otherwise indicated, items should be brought to the homeroom teacher*):

- 3 packs of pencils (1 pack to stay with student; 2 packs for homeroom)
- 20 glue sticks
- 1 pack of skinny dry erase markers (math)
- 1 pack of fat dry erase markers
- 1 pack of cap erasers
- 2 packs of post-it notes
- 1 roll of regular tape (social studies)
- 1 roll of double-sided tape (social studies)
- 1 package of 3x5" index cards, any color (language arts)
- 1 pack of 4 AAA batteries (math)
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 box of band-aids
- 2 containers of clorox wipes (one for homeroom, one for science)
- 2 rolls of paper towels (one for homeroom, one for science)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 bottle of spray cleaner OR disinfecting wipes (related arts)

Individual Student Supplies (*students should keep these with them for class*):

- 4 binders (1") with clear outer cover for page inserts OR 1 larger binder to keep all 4 subjects together (choose based on what will keep students the most organized!)
- 4 packs of 5 tab pocket dividers (one pack for each class)
- 1 pencil pouch
- 1 pack of color pencils
- 2 packs of college ruled notebook paper (divide paper between student's binders)
- 3 graphing composition books (2 for science, 1 for math)
- 1 spiral bound notebook (social studies)
- 1 composition notebook (decorate for language arts; please make sure your name is on it!)
- 1 plastic folder with pockets and holes punched (social studies)
- Students taking art will need a 1" binder with inside pockets, a pencil, a sharpener, and a block eraser.

**\*In addition to the above items, please send \$4 on the first day of school to help cover the cost of student agendas and homework folders that will be provided to students in order to help them stay organized.**
