Grade 2 will emphasize:

- Demonstrate command of the conventions
- Retain and further develop language skills learned in previous grades
- Produce and expand simple and compound sentences.
- Demonstrate understanding that a question is a type of sentence.
- Use singular and plural nouns with matching verbs in sentences.
- Use verbs in sentences to convey a sense of past, present, and future.
- Use common, proper, and possessive nouns.
- Use personal, possessive, and indefinite pronouns.

Grade 3 will emphasize:

- Ask and answer questions to demonstrate understanding of a text, referring explicitly to the text as the basis for the answers.
- Retell stories, including fables, folktales, and myths from diverse cultures; determine the central message, lesson, or moral and explain how it is conveyed through key details in a text
- Describe characters in a story (e.g., their traits, motivations, or feelings) and explain how their actions contribute to the sequence of events.
- Determine the meaning of words and phrases as they are used in a text, distinguishing literal from figurative language.
