

DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

PANTS

- Must be khaki. NO JEANS
- All pants must be worn at the waist with a belt. Belts should be brown or black in color. Studs, rivets, rhinestones, etc. are prohibited.
- Stretch material, stirrup pants, spandex materials, bib/overall pants, sweat pants, biker shorts, denim material and leg warmers are not acceptable uniform attire. **Girls may wear leggings or tights UNDER or WITH shorts or skirts, but not WITHOUT.**

SHORTS/SKIRTS

- Must be khaki. NO JEANS
- Must be longer than your fingertips while at your side.
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times.

SHIRTS

- Must be a navy blue polo shirt with a collar.
- Bare midriffs, tank tops, halter tops and any other items or styles are prohibited.
- Students may wear a solid color long sleeve shirt under the uniform shirt.

SWEATERS, SWEATSHIRTS, HOODIES

- Blue, white, black or gray solid sweaters, sweatshirts or sweater vest may be worn inside the building over a uniform shirt. Small logo on left pocket is acceptable.
- Hoodies are permitted; hoods may not be worn at any time while in school.

SHOES

- Must completely cover the foot. NO flip-flops or sandals.

JEWELRY, ACCESSORIES

- Earrings should be no larger than a quarter. No facial piercings.
- Hair accessories- must be of a functional nature.
- Hats, caps, hoods, other head coverings and bandanas may not be worn in the building, except for bona fide religious or medical reasons.
- Dog collars, tongue rings, wallet chains, picks, removable tooth grills, chains that connect one part of the body to another, or other jewelry or accessories that pose a safety concern for the student or others shall be prohibited. All chains are prohibited at school and on the bus.

The final decision regarding the appropriateness of clothing, jewelry and apparel will be at the discretion of the school administrators. Students who are out of uniform are subject to loss of privileges and/or disciplinary action.
