

LOYOLA LANE CROSSING OF US 183 TO CLOSE FOR BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION

Dear 183 South Project Neighbors:

A phased reconstruction of the US 183 and Loyola Lane intersection began in September 2017 and will continue through late 2018.* The next phase of construction will begin in early February 2018 and will include a long-term closure of the Loyola Lane crossing over US 183, as well as other impacts, noted below.




**Dates are subject to change based on weather and other circumstances*

The Loyola Lane signal will be **TEMPORARILY** removed and the crossing of existing US 183 will be closed for approximately one year while crews construct a bridge over what will be the future 183 South Expressway. Loyola Lane west of US 183 will be closed to traffic for approximately two months while crews construct the new US 183 southbound general-purpose lanes and connect Loyola Lane to them.

In its final condition, Loyola Lane will be a bridge over the new 183 South Expressway. The elevation of Loyola Lane will be similar to what it is today, while the 183 South Expressway will pass underneath Loyola Lane.

Suggested Detour Routes:

- ♦ Southbound US 183 to eastbound Loyola Lane (Purple arrows on map): Continue south on US 183 past Loyola Lane to FM 969 (East Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard). Use the non-signalized Texas turnaround at FM 969 and re-enter US 183 northbound. Take US 183 north to Loyola Lane and turn right onto Loyola Lane.
- ♦ Westbound Loyola Lane to US 183 southbound (Green arrows on map): Turn right onto US 183 and head north to Manor Road. Use the non-signalized Texas turnaround at Manor Road and re-enter US 183 southbound.
- ♦ Access to Loyola Lane west of US 183 (Blue arrows on map): Use Manor Road to reach destinations that are located on Loyola Lane between US 183 and Manor Road.
- ♦ There will be no bicycle and pedestrian access across US 183 at Loyola Lane.
