



This information is for ALL 5th Grade students that are enrolled or interested in joining band for the 2018-2019 school year.

The Creekside Park Junior High Band Program welcomes you! We are proud to say our band program has grown to over 215 members for the 2018-2019 school year. We are excited that you and your family are going to be a part of it! It is time to schedule appointments for individual instrument placements for the upcoming school year. These will be taking place on April 7 and April 11 at CPJH. The purpose of these meetings is to aid students in selecting the instrument they will begin to learn in the 6th grade. Parents will also be given information on instrument rental or purchase, supplies needed, and more. Below are the instructions for how to sign-up. If you enrolled for band for the 2018-2019 school year, you will also receive an email link to this information.

If you are enrolled or interested in band for the 2018-2019 school year, you must sign up for an appointment on April 7 or April 11. Please follow this internet link to the sign-up page:

Once on this page, you will see dates and thirty minute time slots that are available. Please sign up for **one** time slot using your child's name. Please provide your email address and phone number so that we may get in touch with you if something changes.

If you are unable to attend any of the dates and times available, please contact Mr. Wiemar immediately for an alternate time.

Students that do not sign up for a time slot or individual appointment will not be considered for all of the instrument choices. It is important to schedule an appointment as soon as possible.

Students will be able to try and select from the following instruments: flute, clarinet, trumpet, trombone, and percussion. It is important to have at least two or three possible instrument choices in mind. There are many factors that need to be considered when selecting an instrument such as physical size, structure of face, lips, and teeth. The Creekside Park Band Staff will help guide you when choosing an appropriate instrument based on these factors. Our goal is to make sure each student is given the best opportunity to be successful in band.

Students will not find out their instrument placement at these informational meetings. Students and parents will be notified during the week of April 16-20.
