|  | <p style="text-align: center;">229. STUDENT FUNDRAISING</p> <p>1. Purpose<br/>The Board acknowledges that solicitation of funds from students must be limited because compulsory attendance laws make the student a captive donor and such solicitation may disrupt the educational program of the schools.</p> <p>2. Definition<br/>For purposes of this policy, <b>student fundraising</b> shall include solicitation and collection of money by students in exchange for goods or services.</p> <p>3. Authority<br/>The Board prohibits the collection of money by a student for personal benefit in school buildings, on school property or at any school-sponsored activity.</p> <p><u>Collections For Charity</u></p> <p>No funds or items are to be collected within the school district from or by students or employees or citizens for charitable purposes without the prior formal approval of the Superintendent or designee.</p> <p><u>Fundraising Activities</u></p> <p>No fundraising activities are to be held within district buildings or outside district buildings without prior approval of the building principal.</p> <p>No solicitation for ads, sponsorship, or programs shall be conducted by any employees, students, or citizen without the prior approval of the building principal.</p> <p>All requests are to be submitted in writing to the building principal.</p> <p>Funds raised at the interscholastic events under the direction of the Athletic Director, principal, Superintendent and Board are approved as part of the regular athletic program.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall establish rules and regulations which shall specify times and places in which funds may be collected and describe permitted methods of solicitation which do not place undue pressure on students or patrons.</p> |

Delegation of Responsibility</p> <p>Pol. 618</p> | <p>All fundraising activities must comply with all federal, state and local laws, including state sales tax regulations.</p> <p>The building principal shall distribute this policy and relevant procedures to each student organization granted permission to solicit funds.</p> <p>Funds solicited shall be controlled by Policy 618.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
