## Uniforms

As a reminder, all scholars should be in uniform each day. Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays scholars should wear their everyday uniform. On Wednesdays, scholars should wear their dress uniform. Many of our scholars do a wonderful job of coming to school each day in uniform. If a scholar does not follow the dress code, he/she will receive a consequence according to our discipline matrix. This is a reminder of what scholars **should** wear as a part of their uniform on a daily basis, except Wednesdays (dress uniform):

**Everyday** Uniform consists of the following:

- Khaki bottoms (shorts must be worn under skirts)
- Embroidered hunter green polo
- Black or brown plain belt (if applicable)
- Black, white, or brown closed toe shoes (Grey, tan or any other colored shoe is not allowed)
- White socks

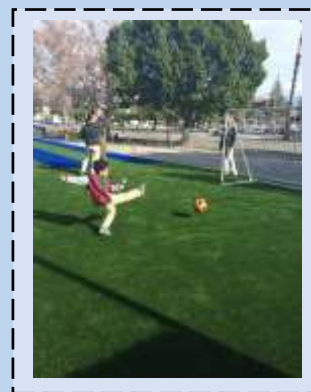
