As you may be aware, on February 23, 2018 there was an organized walkout at Seale Junior High involving approximately 40 students. Once reported, administration, the SJH security guard, and the campus law enforcement officer responded.

In light of the recent tragic events in Florida, Seale Junior High students wanted to have a voice concerning the matter. Campus administration spoke to students to educate them and transitioned the demonstration into a teachable moment. In unison, they respected the lives that were lost in Florida, but in no way partook in a political stance on gun control. We'd like to thank our students for remaining professional while demonstrating their concern and sorrow for those who lost their lives. Students were out of class for approximately seventeen minutes, and returned back to their regular classroom instruction thereafter.
