Student Drop off/pick up location: Please adhere to the parking lot rules and signs for our students’ safety. The student drop off/pick-up area is a NO PARKING ZONE and the only area students should be picked up/dropped off; ***please do not leave your vehicle unattended.*** The handicap parking is for handicap parking only. If you wish you may park in the designated parking lot and walk over to the pick up/drop off area and walk students safely to your vehicle. All red painted curbs are a NO PARKING FIRE ZONE. Please exit the parking lot to the right during school hours as posted. Also be aware of the NO PARKING signs across the street and in front of the school on Palo Alto, NO PARKING from 7am-9am and 12pm-4pm on school days. Fresno PD will be issuing tickets to those not adhering to the parking lot rules.

- ❖ **Morning Entrance:** ALL students are to enter through the cafeteria doors each morning, doors open at 7:30am. Breakfast is provided for FREE! Students are not required to eat breakfast but still must report to the cafeteria for supervision. At 8:10am students are released to the supervised playgrounds until the early bell at 8:25am.
