A-G Requirements

To satisfy this requirement, you must complete the 15 year-long high school courses listed below. Each unit is equal to a year of study in a subject area. A grade of C or higher is required for each course you use to meet any Subject Requirement. At least seven of the 15 year-long courses must be taken in your last two years of high school.

The courses you take to fulfill the Subject Requirement must be certified by the university meeting the requirement and must be included on West Ranch High School's UC-certified course list.

 <p>History/Social Science 2 YEARS REQUIRED</p>	<p><i>Two years of history/social science, including one year of world history, cultures and geography; and one year of U.S. history or one-half year of U.S. history and one-half year of civics or American government.</i></p>
 <p>English 4 YEARS REQUIRED</p>	<p><i>Four years of college-preparatory English that include frequent and regular writing, and reading of classic and modern literature. No more than one year of ESL courses can be used.</i></p>
 <p>Mathematics 3 YEARS REQUIRED, 4 YEARS RECOMMENDED</p>	<p><i>Three years of math that include topics covered in Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, or higher mathematics (take one each year)</i></p>
 <p>Laboratory Science 2 YEARS REQUIRED, 3 YEARS RECOMMENDED</p>	<p><i>Two years of laboratory science providing fundamental knowledge in two of these three subjects: biology, chemistry and physics.</i> <i>UC: biology, chemistry and physics.</i> <i>CSU: 1 year each of biological and physical science</i></p>
 <p>Language other than English 2 YEARS REQUIRED, 3 YEARS RECOMMENDED</p>	<p><i>Two years of the same language other than English.</i></p>
 <p>Visual & Performing Arts 1 YEAR REQUIRED</p>	<p><i>A single year-long approved arts course from a single visual and performing arts discipline: dance, music, drama/theater, or visual arts.</i></p>
 <p>College Preparatory Elective 1 YEAR REQUIRED</p>	<p><i>One year (two semesters), in addition to those required in the "a-f" above, chosen from the following areas: visual and performing art, history, social science, English, advanced mathematics, laboratory science and language other than English (a third year in the language used for the "e" requirement or two years of another language).</i></p>
