



Code of Conduct for the Student Athlete

Becoming a member of the Titan Athletic family is an achievement every student can be proud of. In addition to their commitment to academic curriculum, students must dedicate themselves to the extra-curricular program, a code of ethics, and a standard of expectations which may supersede their fellow classmates. In order to attain the title of Student-Athlete, these standards and expectations must be acknowledged, and sustained:

Academics:

It is required that every Student Athlete maintain a 2.0 grade point average. Student Athletes are expected to put forth effort in every class.

Personal Conduct:

Student Athletes are expected to maintain good citizenship at all times. Should an athlete receive a referral(s), or a valid complaint from a staff member, in all likelihood there will be ensuing consequences.

- If you partake in conduct detrimental to the team, in all likelihood you will be reprimanded. You may also be suspended, and/or possibly removed from the team.
- Should you become a catalyst for a negative environment because of your attitude, poor sportsmanship, and lack of respect for authorities, teammates, coaches, opponents, or officials, in all likelihood you will be reprimanded and possibly suspended. Should the offence be egregious enough you may be removed from the team.

Commitment:

This is important for the parent and the player.

- If you are choosing to do something else that is optional rather than participate in practice that will be construed as an unexcused absence. If you are missing practices for unexcused reasons, you will not play.
- Players are expected to be punctual for all practices, games, and team events. If you are not on time, in all likelihood you will be reprimanded.
- Practices may be extended past the normal time. This is the coach's discretion so time commitment is required.
- If you are not prepared with the proper practice attire, you will not be allowed to practice. This will be considered missing practice.
- Should you have an unexcused absence from school, you will not be allowed to participate in either the practice or in the game. A minimum of three periods for the day are mandatory.

Playing time:

Your playing time will be predicated by your academic eligibility, personal conduct, commitment, and skill level. Skill level is the final determining factor for who plays and how much. Skill level is based on: the player's heart, intelligence quotient, leadership, competitive desire, athleticism, practice performance, and finally game performance. Playing time MUST be earned and is NOT guaranteed for anyone.
