Kamakau's Admissions Policy –

Families interested in enrolling at Ke Kula 'o Samuel M. Kamakau, LPCS are highly encouraged to complete the following steps, which provide opportunities for the family to determine whether the school meets their educational needs served by its vision and mission.

- Hele i ka Hālāwai Ho'olauna 'Ohana (Attend one family informational meeting)
 - Shared at the family informational meeting is Kamakau's vision, mission and school goals.
- Ho'opihapiha a ho'ihoi i ka Palapala Noi Komo. E kelepona i ke ke'ena no ke kōkua me ia palapala. (Complete and submit the application online at www.kamakau.com. Contact the office if assistance is needed. A hardcopy will be provided if requested.)
- Hele i ka Nīnauele 'Ohana (Attend a family interview.)
 - The interview is solely reflective and is meant to support families by providing them with more information about Kamakau's unique Hawaiian language program. The success of students is closely tied to the family's commitment to the language and the child's desire to learn Hawaiian.
- Kipa Kula (School Visit for families new to Immersion).
 - This visit is meant to introduce the family and student to a "Hawaiian-only" environment.
- Haumana papa 7-12: Helu papa i nā papa kūhelu i puka ai ka haumana ma ka palapala noi komo. (For all students entering grades 7-12: List all course titles and ACCN no. for all credits earned.)
 - This is a request for secondary students as course offerings each semester are limited. Kamakau may not be able to serve the needs of all students due to limited staff and courses.
