- Exploring numerous Smithsonian Museums, like the National Museum of Natural History and the National Air and Space Museum

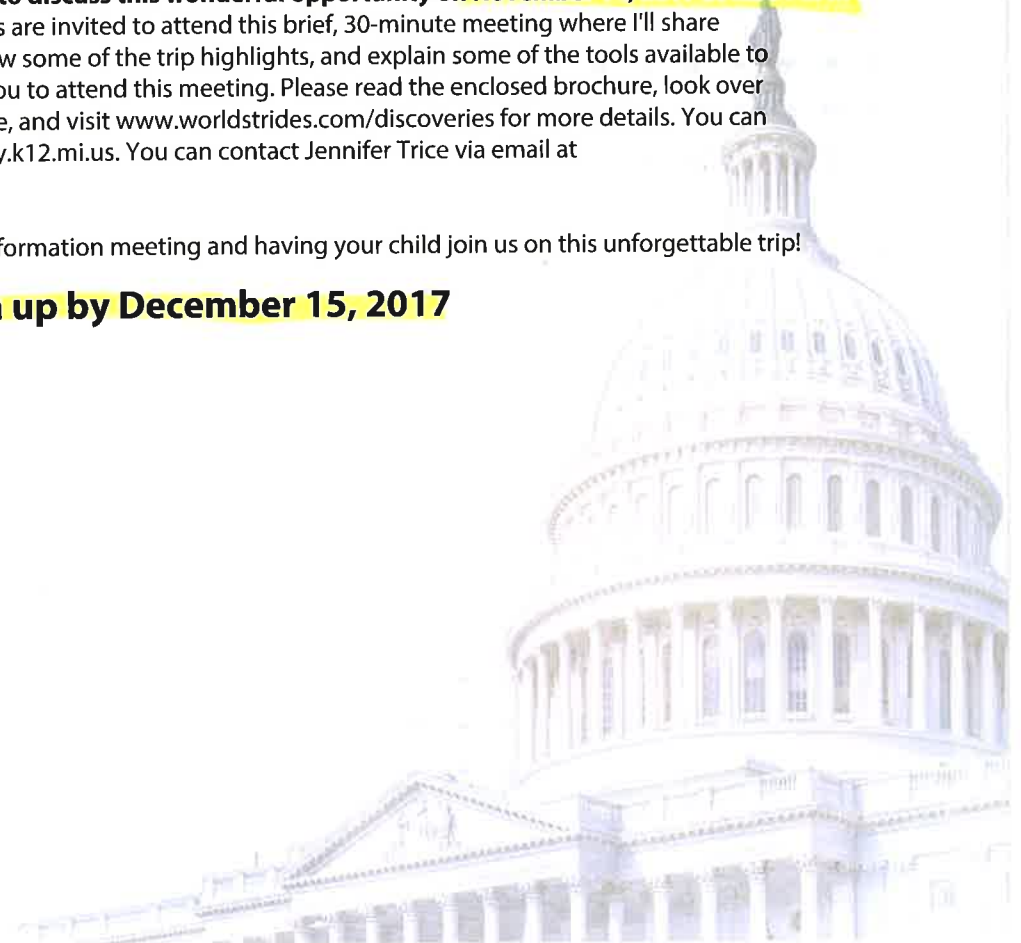
