Coldspring-Oakhurst High School was proud to host this year's Area 6 Robotics Contest on Saturday, Jan. 13.

More than 50 students from seven school districts came together to put their problem-solving and robotics abilities to the test.

Student teams competed in two divisions: Intermediate (4th through 8th grade), or Advanced (9th through 12th grade).

"Robotics is an incredible avenue for students to work on hands-on, collaborative projects," said COCISD Instructional Technology Specialist Kel-

lie Lahey. "Students have the opportunity to design, collaborate, plan, redesign, construct, create, assemble, invent, reinvent, write, present, and compete to see who has developed a winning robot."

The Inventions contest consisted of identifying, developing, and presenting a robotic solution to a real world problem. COHS teams Charise Lincoln and Michael Moran, and Rachael Duwel and Collin Nolan, earned 1st and 2nd place in their division and will advance to the state robotics competition.
