Meningitis Vaccination Clinic 2017-1018

Dear Seniors & Parents of Seniors,

According to state immunization laws, students planning to attend an institute of higher education are required to have a meningitis vaccination prior to admission. In an effort to assist in college preparation, we will be offering a Meningitis Vaccination clinic here at Rosebud-Lott High school for all qualifying seniors.

Date & Time: February 8th 1pm - 3pm in School Nurses office

In order to have the vaccination administered here at school the following **must be turned in to the School Nurse by February 6th 3:30 pm:**

- Signed Consent form/questionnaire (attached) for those under the age of 18 this must be completed by a parent.
- Copy of insurance card or Medicaid card— front and Back—(bring to nurse and copies can be made at school) Note: for private insurance bring pharmacy card you use for getting prescriptions filled
- If you do not have insurance and would like to pay out of pocket the Cost for one Shot without insurance approval is \$130.
- NOTE: if your insurance has a co-pay for prescriptions, you will need to bring cash or check on the day of shot clinic.

This vaccination clinic is being offered as a courtesy to those who qualify and is not mandatory. However, we would like to encourage all seniors who need the meningitis vaccination to take advantage of this opportunity as it will not be offered again in the 2017- 2018 school year.
