

The uniform practice at Park School follows AUSD's Board of Education mandatory School Uniform Policy.

- > Tops:
 Collared with long or short sleeves, Navy blue, white, or light blue. Park
 T-shirts are also allowed. Spaghetti straps and mid-drift tops are not
 permitted.
- > Bottoms:
 Navy blue or khaki, fitted at the waist or elastic band. Must be twill, cotton, cotton blend, or polyester blend. Jeans and Leggings used as pants are not permitted. Shorts must be between mid-thigh to the knee, nothing shorter. Includes shorts, skirts, skorts, jumpers, pants.
- Shoes: Closed toe shoes are required for safety. Open-toed shoes, heels or wedges are not allowed.
- ➤ College Spirit Day Fridays: On the First Friday of the Month students, are encouraged to wear college attire to promote a college-bound atmosphere at Park.
- Themed Spirit Days:
 On certain days, students are encouraged to wear themed, spirited clothing. Dress code including, no leggings, shorts/skirts not shorter than mid length, close-toed shoes, no spaghetti straps, must still be followed.

Students not in uniform will be sent to the office during their recess time to change. Parents are asked to wash and return the borrowed clothing the next day. For safety reasons, students wearing inappropriate shoes will have their parents called immediately and must have someone bring an alternate pair of allowable shoes to school for the student.

Financial Consideration: No student will be penalized in any way for failing to wear the uniform for reason of financial hardship. Please see our home school coordinators, Ms. Rose or Ms. Lynn who will align you with community resources for uniforms.
