A little bit about us...

Lubbock-Cooper North Elementary was the first LCISD campus built within Lubbock city limits and the second LCISD elementary school constructed. Opened in 2002, North was constructed in a modern fashion with plenty of space to accommodate the needs of our youngest Pirates. In 2016, North opened a new expansion which included 16 classrooms with collaborative areas and state-of-the-art technology.

North serves approximately 900 students in pre-school through fifth grade. There are 80 certified teachers on the campus and the student-teacher ratio in the classroom is 20:1.

What we offer...

Curriculum at North Elementary is based on the TEKS Resource System, the State of Texas mandated curriculum requirements.

In addition to maintaining state requirements, the North campus offers many unique learning opportunities including music classes, physical education classes, and art classes. North also offers Gifted and Talented, English as a Second Language, bilingual support, dyslexia services, before- and after-school tutoring, daytime and evening student performances, differentiated instruction, Balanced Literacy Framework, full technology integration, positive behavior systems, integrated social studies, project-based science, iPads, Apple TVs, SMART boards, iRead, Read 180, Systems 44, and more!

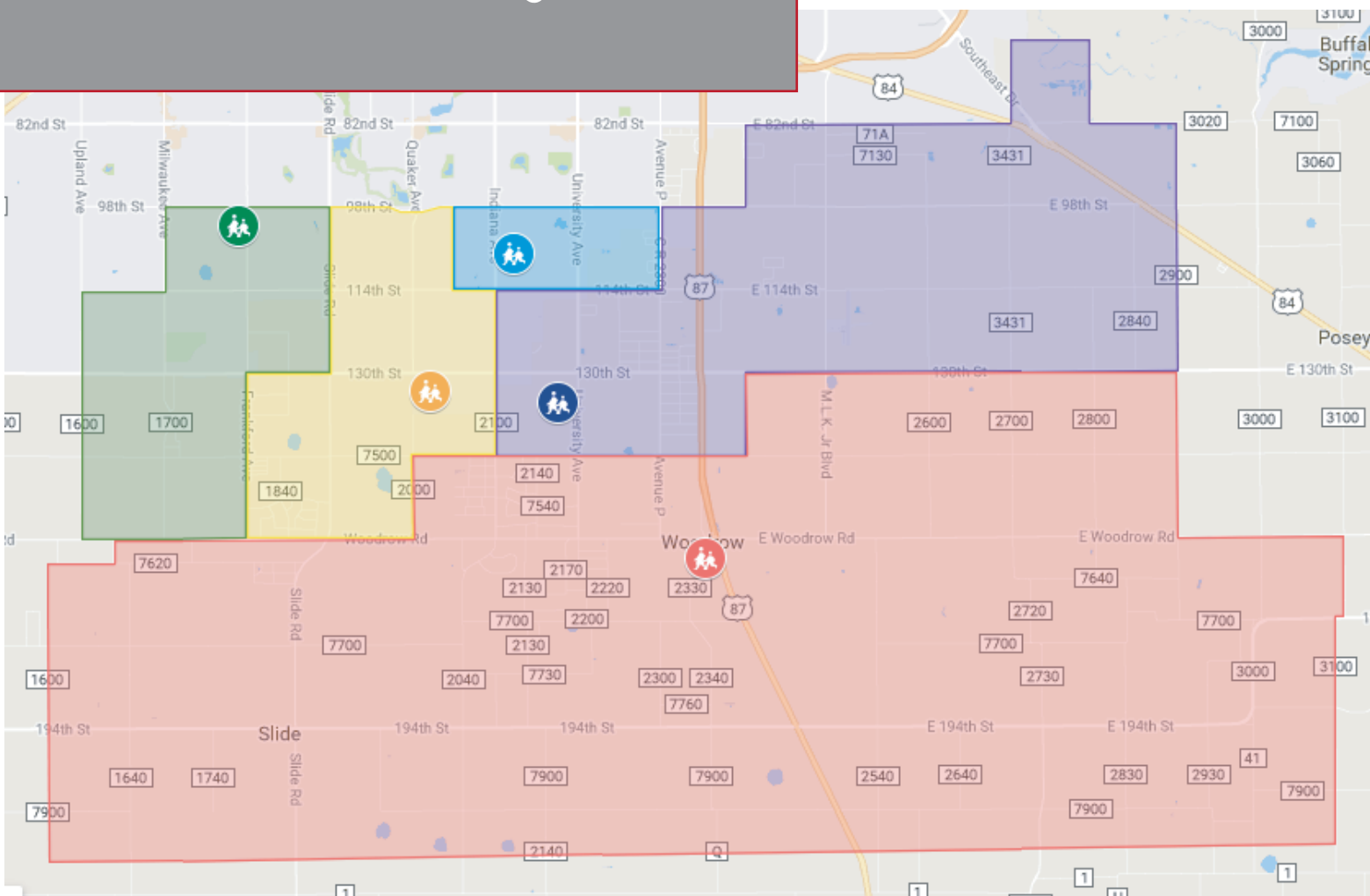
