## FAFSA

**Free Application for Federal Student Aid** - The FAFSA application is a very important part of the College application process. This application will be available starting October 1, 2016. Regardless of which college/technical school you plan to attend, you will need to fill this application out so they can put together a financial package showing how your education is going to be paid for. Try to fill this application out as soon as you can after it opens in October. You can use your tax return from last year to complete this document.
