The meeting opened by reviewing minutes from the previous meeting dated December 6, 2017. A motion was made by Ms. Burton to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Ms. Paterson. The vote was a counted vote with 5 in favor and 0 opposed. The motion passed.

Old Agenda Items

- **Standard Student Attire (SSA)**

The SOT reviewed the status of the proposal to re-vote on SSA at Gibson Middle School, including feedback from the SSA Community Meeting held on Wednesday, December 13, 2017 and the SSA committee meeting held on Thursday, January 11, 2018. Members reviewed changes to SSA options for the 2018 vote: all sweatshirts in solid approved colors will be allowed. Members also discussed timelines for the upcoming vote (March 26, 2018) and plans for school spirit days.

New Agenda Items

- **Review of School Data**

Members reviewed multiple school data sources: demographics, math and reading SBAC results and achievement gaps, math and reading STAR progress monitoring data, median growth percentile data, staff composition and retention rates, parent/student survey data, and attendance rates.

- **Review of School Budgets**

Members reviewed budgets from FY 17 in comparison to budgets from FY18: strategic, Hope2, Magnet, Title I, Title I PISA, and Title III. Members discussed loss of 1003(a) (\$25,000) and Title I Set Aside (\$169,950) funding sources, as well as budgets that had not yet been determined: SB178 (\$387,600) and additional magnet funding (\$219,166).

- **Review of the School Performance Plan**

Members reviewed and prioritized school spending to address a potential loss of funding in the amount of \$801,716 for the 2018-19 school year.
