



## Frequently Asked Questions: Bartlett Honors Academy



### **Q1. What is the Honors Academy?**

A1. The Honors Academy will be a co-hort within the schools. Students enrolled in the Honors Academy will be expected to earn 14 Honors Units in 4 years and complete 12 service hours each year.

### **Q2. How do I earn Honors Units?**

A2. Completion of an Honors Class, Dual-Enrollment class, or semester Advanced-Placement class will earn 1 unit while year long Advanced Placement course will earn 1.5 units.

### **Q3. Is the Project of Impact tied to a grade?**

A3. No, the Project of Impact is a culminating project that will fulfill the final requirement of the Honors Academy. The project will not be tied to a classroom grade.

### **Q4. Can students still take Honors, Dual-Enrollment, and Advanced Placement classes if they are not in the Honors Academy?**

A4. Yes, all students will still be able to take Honors, Dual-Enrollment, and Advanced Placement classes.

### **Q5. Will the diploma be different than a regular education diploma?**

A5. Yes, the diploma will be different. Successful completion of the Honors Academy, will result in a BCS diploma.

### **Q6. Once a student is accepted into the Honors Academy, is the Intent Letter a binding contract?**

A6. No, if a student decides that he/she cannot fulfill all the requirements, they will be allowed out of the academy. This will mean that they will not be eligible to graduate as a part of the Honors Academy.

### **Q7. Will the students in the Honors Academy remain at the Freshman Academy?**

A7. No, the students will move up with their class to Bartlett High School after freshman year.
