

## Closed Campus Policy

Tulare City Schools has a closed campus policy. This means that once a student arrives at school, he/she is not allowed to leave the campus. The only exceptions to this rule are:

- Leaving the campus for a doctor's appointment or leaving for other reasons with a parent. Parents must check students out through the office.
- Going home for lunch. Students who live in close proximity to their school and have a note on file in the office, signed by a parent, allowing them to go directly home for lunch, are allowed to do so. Indicating "yes" on the Home for Lunch section of the Parents' Rights Signature Card satisfies this requirement. This permission is for students to go home for lunch only with parent supervision. The student may not go to a store, a restaurant, or a friend's house. No other students (except siblings) may go with him/her.

Students leaving for home to eat lunch must sign out before going and sign back in upon their return.
