1. Scholarships available: www.collegeraptor.com
2. Students from California school districts are eligible for all awards below. The following link has a list of Scholarship Programs that has given out more than 1 million dollars. Please check the website regularly. www.studentscholarships.org/newsletter.php.
3. **CSOLAR IV SOUTH AND CSOLAR IV WEST SCHOLARSHIP** for the 2017/2018 academic school year. If no applications are submitted from your high school by the deadline date, the scholarship funds will be allocated to another school in the county. Each student will be responsible for providing and submitting the required materials as listed in the Submission Requirements area of the application form. ***Please note that if a student fails to submit all required items, the application will not be considered.*** The Tenaska CSOLAR IV South, LLC and CSOLAR IV West, LLC 2018 scholarship application **filing date has been extended from Monday, February 12, 2018 to Thursday, February 15, 2018.** .See Counseling for more info.
4. **THE BRAD FOWLER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** offers a \$5,000 scholarship to five high school seniors in San Diego County. The ACT Student Champion Award recognizes one student in each state who is tenacious and persistent, no matter the challenge, and is prepared for life after high school with a goal in mind and plan in place. ACT Student Champions receive a \$500 non-renewable scholarship, certificate, plaque, and state-level recognition. Please encourage students in the graduating class of 2018 who have taken the ACT who fit the following criteria to apply: A student who has overcome challenges and can articulate education and career actions. Students must have a composite ACT score of a 22 on a single test date or a 3.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale. Preference will be given to underrepresented and/or first-generation college students. Applications can be found at www.act.org/readinesschampions. Applications are **due December 31, 2017**, and champions will be **notified on or before April 2, 2018**.
