GRANT PROGRAMS

INNOVATIONS IN EDUCATION - Classroom Grants

This program puts money directly into the classroom for special activities that enhance enrich learning activities. Teachers may apply for a grant to cover supplies or programs that are often paid for out of their own pockets.

PROJECT: ENRICHMENT - Program Grants

Teachers, coaches, advisors and others who administer enrichment programs may apply for a grant to provide funds for their co-curricular or extra-curricular after-school activities for New Haven students.

VIRGINIA SWIHART MEMORIAL FUND - New Teacher Grants

Established in memory of a long time District principal and administrator. This fund helps support beginning teachers by providing small stipends for classroom activities.

BRIAN KELLY MEMORIAL TUTORING FUND - Program Grants

This program was named in memory of a Logan student who passed away at a young age. Teachers or administrators may request a grant for their tutoring program helping New Haven students.
