WHAT IS *COLLEGE GO GET IT WEEK*?

Lancaster ISD has declared September 15-19, 2014 *College Go Get It Week*. This week will kick off with a host of college readiness workshops, college paraphernalia and information throughout each K-12 campus. Students, faculty and staff will focus on information about preparing for college, getting into college, and graduating with *More Than A Diploma*. The theme for this year is Aviation.

WHO IS PARTICIPATING?

LISD Campuses are supporting the college curriculum in a few weeks and taking time to discuss their college alma mater. Along with school staff, many community partners will volunteer to assist and support *College Go Get It Week*.

WHAT ARE THE ACTIVITIES?

The Friday prior to *College Go Get It Week*, with the leadership of Student Council Class Officers, each grade level should begin decorating their hall promoting college (i.e. banners, posters, door decor, etc). Judges will rank each hallway on Wednesday, September 17th. The grade level hallway ranked #1 will win and enjoy ice cream during the pep rally for the entire class.

Below are planned activities of how our students, faculty and staff will be encouraged to “go get it” and “take flight” during this district initiative:

MONDAY: *College Go Get It Week Lift Off!* Teachers will discuss with students the first 10 minutes of class their college experience and encourage students to prepare early for college and visit the College Center weekly.

Flight Plan! Senior English classes will submit copies of college essay drafts written by students to the College Center Friday, September 19th. Essays will become a part of the student’s profile. Seniors will complete and submit a flight plan.

TUESDAY: *Take Flight Application Marathon!* Seniors will complete applications throughout the day. Faculty, staff and volunteers will be encouraged to sign up to assist students with their applications in the cafeteria.

College Road Map! AVID students will road map activity in class.

WEDNESDAY: *Ticketing & Boarding for SAT/ACT!* Students enrolled in the ACT class will complete at least 1 college entrance exam registration. Faculty, staff and volunteers will be encouraged to sign up to assist students with the registration process.

AVID Parent Night! AVID students and parents will engage in discussion about program expectations and goals.

THURSDAY: ***Classroom Departure to College Fair Arrival!*** Military/College recruiters will set-up during lunches. Concurrently, students who need to follow-up and/or complete task from previous days will be encouraged to stop by the College Center during lunch. College Advisors and representatives will be available to assist with various processes and answer questions. Everyone will attend the Cedar Valley College Fair from 6pm-8pm. Students who attend may be given extra credit at the teacher's discretion.

FRIDAY: ***Area Navigation...Show Me the \$\$\$!*** Financial aid and scholarship presentations will be conducted by Cedar Valley Office of Financial Aid in the Auditorium for all seniors to assist them with navigating the financial process.

College Go Get It Landing! Greek staff will approach the run-way to closeout CGGIW at the pep rally with a special presentation organized by Mrs. Terrell.
