

# Norwin School District Community Foundation Scholarships

Details and Applications Available in the Norwin High School Guidance Office

1. **David J. Nelson Scholarship** – 85% GPA or higher, love of athletics, broad interests through commitment to music, art or community, shows genuine acceptance of peers regardless of background.
2. **Thomas J. and Gladys Sowash Stoker Scholarship** – resident of Irwin Borough, minimum QPA of 2.5, service to school and community.
3. **Carol Terbot Memorial Scholarship** – FBLA or DECA, attendance.
4. **M. Dolores Fink Memorial Scholarship** – must go to a girl, pursuing degree in Physical Education, Health or Nursing.
5. **Elynor Mae Bruce Sutter Memorial Scholarship** – major in one of these fields listed in order: Piano performance, music education (piano, vocal or string), Vocal Music, Stringed Instrument Performance, Music Education (any instrument), Most outstanding choral student.
6. **Fawcett-Deslam Memorial Scholarship** – pursuing degree in elementary education.
7. **Frank Benevento Memorial Scholarship** – attend Pitt or PSU, community activities.
8. **Frank S. Keough Memorial Scholarship** – community activities.
9. **J. Walter Miles Memorial Scholarship** – attending Pitt or Cornell, strong math and science.
10. **Pastarini Memorial Scholarship** – excel and plan to major in Vocal Music, Music Education, Major in History (not social studies), Major in Education, leadership.
11. **Roy J. Martin Memorial Scholarship** – leadership and academic achievement, part of football or women's basketball at Norwin School District, major in teaching, secondary education, social studies or related discipline.
12. **The R. Neil Faust Scholarship** – Given to sixth-grade students for summer enrichment programs in the student's area of interest.
13. **Michael T. Sweeney, Jr. R.A.K. Scholarship** – This award is for a student pursuing a secondary education in technology.
14. **Michael T. Sweeney Jr. R.A.K. Outstanding Technology Education Student Award** - This is a second award for a student pursuing a secondary education in technology.
15. **Michael T. Sweeney Jr. R.A.K (Experience) Award** – This is a mini-awards designed to give students in the Norwin School District the opportunity to attend an event/activity with their entire family that would otherwise be hard to attain (i.e., tickets to the school picnic, a movie, bowling night, or a sports event).

- 16. Norwin Chamber of Commerce** – A \$2,500 scholarship is awarded each year to a child or grandchild of a Norwin Chamber member or an employee of a Norwin Chamber member. The scholarship is awarded to a high school senior and there is no stipulation on the school district they attend.
- 17. The Del P. Nolfi Memorial Fund - Norwin Student Council Scholarship** – These are leadership scholarship(s) for Norwin Student Council Members. The fund has been established for the late Del P. Nolfi (of Glassport).
- 18. Paul and Anne Smiy Scholarship** – This scholarship is for students who pursue service to school and community.
