The Jackson Parish School Board met in special session at 12:00 noon on June 17, 2015, at its regular meeting place, 315 Pershing Highway, Jonesboro, Louisiana. The following were present for roll call: Dennis Clary, Wade McBride, Mary Saulters, Gloria Davis, Melissa Perry and Calvin Waggoner. Gerry Mims was absent.

The meeting was called to order by President Dennis Clary.

Wade McBride gave the invocation.

Calvin Waggoner led the board in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Mary Saulters, seconded by Calvin Waggoner and carried to approve purchase of 30 computers from Dell at a cost of \$27,513.30 for Special Education Department to be paid from Special Education - IDEA grant money. (Includes maintenance, damage and technical support)

Motion was made by Melissa Perry, seconded by Wade McBride and carried to approve purchase of 8 welding machines at Weston High School in the amount of \$14,612.88 and 2 welding machines at Quitman High School in the amount of \$3,653.22 from Weslco to be paid from Career Development Funds in General Fund.

Motion was made by Melissa Perry, seconded by Mary Saulters and carried that the board go into executive session to discuss strategy in this litigation, which is entitled Johnson and United States versus Jackson Parish School Board, civil action #65-11,130 on the docket of the United States District Court for the Western District of Louisiana.

Motion was made by Calvin Waggoner, seconded by Melissa Perry and carried to return to open session with no action taken.

Motion was made by Melissa Perry, seconded by Mary Saulters and carried to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 12:53 p.m.
