TLC ACADEMY STUDENT POLICIES

ATTENDANCE: PARENTAL CONSENT FOR ABSENCE

POLICY

(REQUIRED BY LAW)

Before a district or charter school may count a student in attendance under this section, or in attendance when the student was allowed to leave campus during any part of the school day, **the district or charter school shall adopt a policy** addressing parental consent for a student to leave campus and distribute the policy to staff and to all parents of students in the district or charter school. [19 TAC 129.21\(d\)](#).

A student absent from School for any portion of a school day shall provide a note to the campus office upon return that describes the reason for the absence. Before a student may leave campus at any time during the school day, a note must be provided to the campus office describing the reason for the absence. The note shall be signed by the student's parent or, if the student is eighteen years or older, or is an emancipated minor, by the student. The Chief Executive Officer shall ensure that this policy is distributed to all parents and students of the School.
