This morning, due to the vigilance of our students and parents, we were made aware of a threat to multiple Manhattan high schools, including the High School for Health Professions & Human Services, on social media.

We immediately notified NYPD about the threat as well as the Borough Safety Director, and the Superintendent's Office. The NYPD Counter Terrorism unit has since confirmed that the person who made the threat has been apprehended and taken into custody.

There will be extra school safety agents at the school to ensure student and staff safety. Thank you for your cooperation as we work together to ensure that our school continues to provide a safe, supportive learning environment for all of our students. It is important that we remain vigilant, and if we see something, say something.
