- IV. Review of School Budget
  - a. Budget drop from \$70 last year to \$60 this year
  - b. Student current count is about 625. More students have moved out than in
  - c. Budget based on Oct 1 count.
- V. Trustland Plan Revision (Additional Funding)
  - a. Current amount is \$31,499.
  - b. There is a \$2700 carry over from last year.
  - c. Teachers want to focus on using it for technology
  - d. 6 classrooms still need a LCD projector
  - e. Movement to approve funding for 4 classrooms to receive the LCD projector at a cost of \$2500-\$3,000. Council approved this unanimously.
  - f. School is looking into cost of a rotating cart of 36 ipad's, notebooks, or android devices.
  - g. Council asked for more input from teachers as to how they will use this technology. Mr. Spindler will ask the teachers for additional information.

- h. Heritage West is doing a fundraiser mid Jan. for Copper Canyon. Walmart has been approached for a discount.
  - i. Another option for using the funding is to use it for additional sound systems in classrooms.
