



THE RODE FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

The Rode brothers (Bob, Tim, and Greg) were graduates of Baker High School who became successful as business entrepreneurs and wished to give back to deserving Baker High School seniors interested in pursuing higher education. The Rode Brothers Scholarships will be in the amount of \$5,000 depending on rigor of course load, school/community involvement, and character. Priority will be given to those who attend the University of Oregon, but this is not the sole determinant.

APPLICANTS MUST:

1. Be a graduating senior from Baker High School in Baker City, Oregon.
2. Have plans to attend a four year public university in Oregon following high school graduation. Scholarships will be paid directly to the recipient's university into the recipient's account. If the recipient does not attend a four year university or delays entry into college, the award will be rescinded.
3. Have a minimum GPA of 3.25 or higher.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE APPLICANT:

1. Complete the required information on the attached application form online at www.baker.k12.or.us and include in your attachments.
2. Submit a copy of your unofficial high school grade transcript.
3. Submit a copy of your high school resume. This should include your major high school/community activities, volunteer service, awards, and work experiences. Indicate any leadership positions and/or special honors/awards.
4. Complete and attach a short essay (600-800 words) describing yourself. Please discuss your anticipated career pathway and how college will support this choice. Include any other information that you would like the panel to know about you.
5. Submit three letters of recommendation; two from school faculty members and one from a community member.
6. Your completed application form and attachments must be returned to the Baker High School Guidance Center by April 1.
