Annual Notice of Physical Education Requirements

Los Gatos Union School District strives to provide the highest quality educational experience we can envision for our students. Included in that is a high quality Physical Education Program in our elementary schools. California Education Code governs how much physical education is taught in each classroom. As per California Education Code 51210 (g), first through fifth grade teachers are required to teach 200 minutes of physical education over 10 instructional days. It is at the discretion of the classroom teacher as to how and when these minutes are distributed over this time frame.

We are providing this notice to inform parents/guardians regarding this information and if you have questions regarding physical education minutes you should first contact your child's teacher or principal. If there are further questions or information that the school was unable to answer, you may contact Marla Rodriguez, Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services/Human Resources.
