Dear Parents and Community Members,

The Oregon Department of Education has issued this report card to give a comprehensive view of your student compared to WLWV and schools across the state of Oregon.

During the 2013-14 school year, our average attendance was 98.8%. This demonstrates a high level of commitment on the part every TRCS family. Overall, we earned a ranking on this report card of a high 4 (we missed a 5 by two tenths of a point).
 · 96% Met or Exceeded Reading Benchmarks (62% Exceeded)
 · 96% Met or Exceeded Math Benchmarks (63% Exceeded)
 · 86.5% Met or Exceeded Science Benchmarks (56.8% Exceeded)

The State of Oregon considers “individual student growth” (and actually weights it twice). The higher the test scores, the more difficult it is to attain the same level of growth between years. We together, have one of the best schools in the State of Oregon. Congratulations to our students, families and staff for this amazing report card!

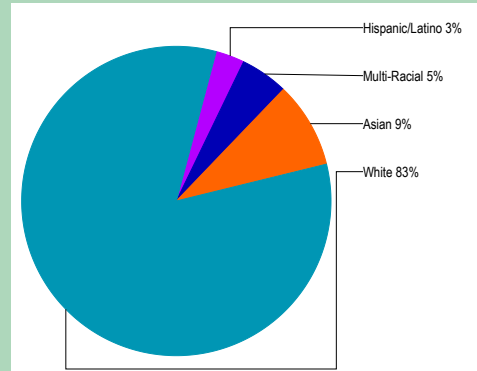

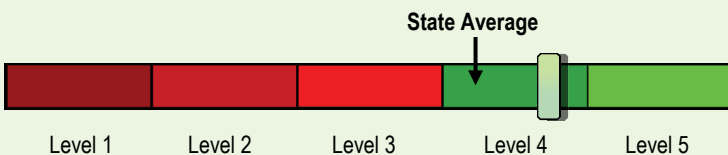


OVERALL STATE RATING

HOW ARE STUDENTS AT THIS SCHOOL PERFORMING COMPARED TO THOSE AT OTHER SCHOOLS?

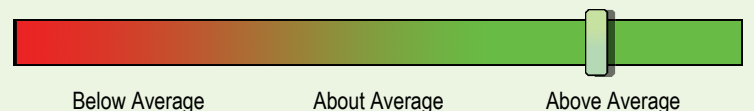

Compared to all schools statewide in 2013-14, this school is rated as Level 4.



- Level 1** = Falls into the bottom 5% of schools

- Level 4** = Falls between 44% and 90% of schools
- Level 5** = Falls into the top 10% of schools

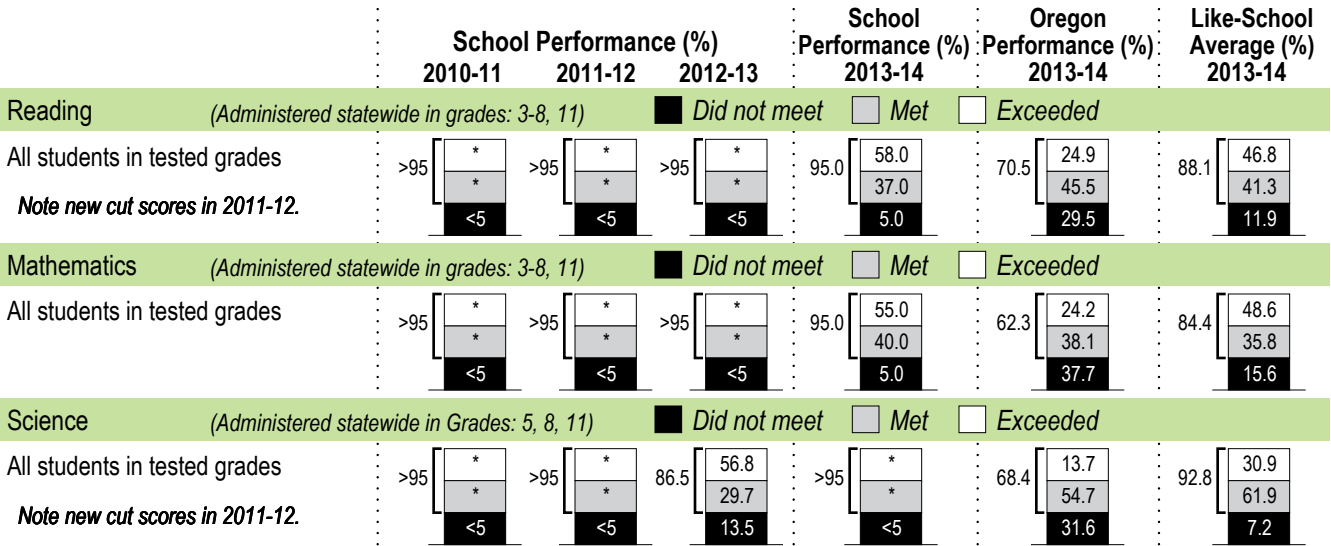
