

Studies show that PAT can have a positive impact on families. Evaluations have found:

- PAT children have significantly better language, problem-solving, and social development at age 3.
- Children continue to do better in the early elementary grades as evidenced by higher scores on standardized reading and math tests.
- Parents are more confident in their parenting skills and knowledge and they read more to their children.
- Parents stay more involved in their child's education, both at school and at home.
- Schools benefit because developmental delays in children can be identified and resolved early.

- Scheduled once a month during days/evenings
- Addressing parenting concerns
- Individualized for both parent and child
- Provide ideas for age-appropriate parent/child activities.

Group Meetings/Playgroups offer opportunities for parents to learn more about parenting issues and child development:

- Offered during days and evenings
- Provide parent/child activity sessions
- Parents learn how to observe their child with other children

Screenings, offered as a source of information about a child's developmental level, are provided:

- Language, social and motor skills
- Periodic monitoring of developmental progress
- Health, hearing, and vision checks.

Resource Network is provided to help families identify and connect with needed resources:

- Parent Educators help families overcome barriers to accessing services.
