FIRST AID FOR AN EPILEPTIC SEIZURE

- KEEP CALM. The student is usually not suffering or in any danger.
- Help the student to a safe place but do NOT restrain movements.
- PLACE STUDENT ON SIDE to prevent choking on vomit or saliva.
- Loosen tight clothing
- Do NOT force anything into the mouth or give anything to drink.
- Observe the student until fully conscious.
- Report the occurrence to an administrator and notify family per instructions in health file
- Most seizures are over in a few minutes.

If the seizure is prolonged or the student stops breathing, call 911.

OBSERVATIONS TO REPORT

NOTE: The time the seizure started, any condition that may have triggered the seizure (heat, cold, excessive exercise, food), anything unusual that occurred before the seizure (sleepiness, unusual sounds, complaints) and the duration of the seizure and the parts of the body that were involved.
