Dear Parents and Community Members,

An Oregon School rating for EAGLE CAP Innovative High School is not available because of the numbers of students in grade 11. (This is to maintain confidentiality for our students.) EAGLE CAP is a hybrid, non-traditional high school model, which combines opportunities for high quality teacher-led instruction, with online curriculum options and independent study coursework. College coursework is also an option and provides students with the opportunity to work toward their associate's degree.

Additionally, students are required to complete a career pathway option for graduation. Access to Baker High School and Baker Technical Institute provides ample opportunity to fulfill this requirement.

The EAGLE CAP Site Council meets to review school data and areas of improvement. EAGLE CAP staff will focus on reading, writing and math as it relates to the common core state standards. Parents and/or student advocates assist students using data gathered through online grade books and quarterly student led conferences.

School Improvement Goals focus on reading, writing and math. EAGLE CAP offers enrichment opportunities through electives that include innovative pathways to employment and college.

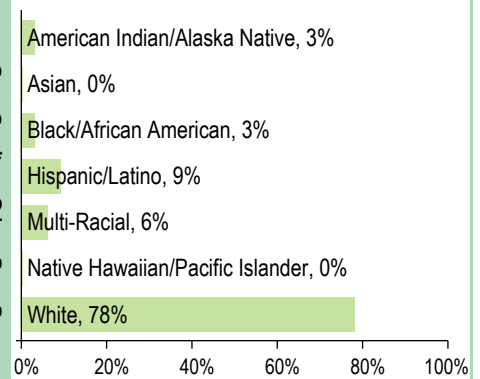

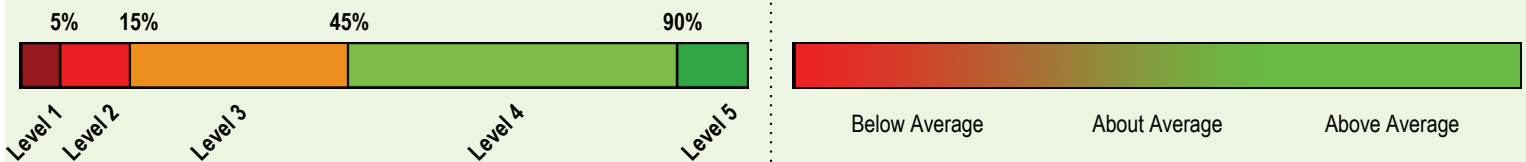
