Acceleration is a well-researched, successful intervention for gifted students, but it is still intimidating to think about having your own son or daughter accelerate in school. The presenter will focus on questions frequently asked about academic acceleration, including, "Will my child make friends in the new grade?", "Will my child be well-rounded?", and "How do we know if it's the right decision?".
