



**What's next? We must begin immediately with the whole-hearted implementation of our action plan. This must be a collaborative effort that involves all stakeholders. Through our PLCs and SLCs, we must continue to refine instructional strategies and find and implement effective interventions that work for *all* our students. Focus groups will continue to meet periodically to monitor and evaluate progress as the school works on the five schoolwide areas of growth listed below:**

- **Develop a systematic approach to provide families who have internet access a chance to use that technology to keep apprised of their child's progress.**
- **The A-G completion rate and graduation rate is very low in spite of the school's interventions**
- **Advisory period is not delivered to the students in a consistent, meaningful manner**
- **The SLCs lack consistency in their development of academic programs which align with their titles of: SciTech, Humanitas, MTCA**
- **Incorporate a wider variety of instructional strategies which may include (Active participation by the students in the lesson, regular Checking for Understanding by the teachers, the use of academic wait time, meaningful cooperative learning activities)**

**I believe we Eagles did a very creditable job in going through the self-study process and in providing the visiting team a true and unvarnished picture of our school. Of course it would have been gratifying to receive a six-year term in recognition of the many fine areas of strength and the many accomplishments of our students as a result of the efforts of a concerned and caring staff.
