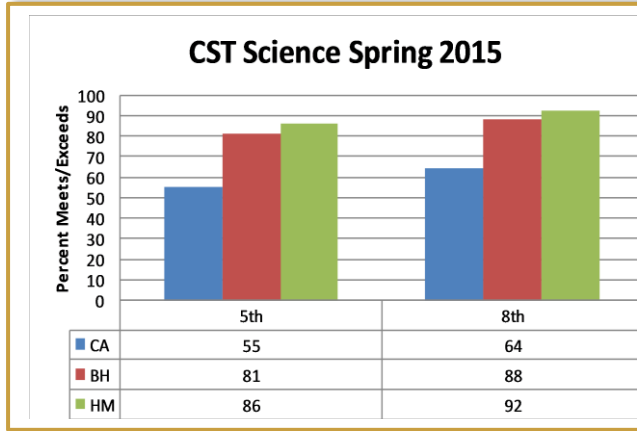


Our mission at Horace Mann School is to empower students to become independent, self-motivated learners who function productively in society and who are prepared to continue on into higher education.

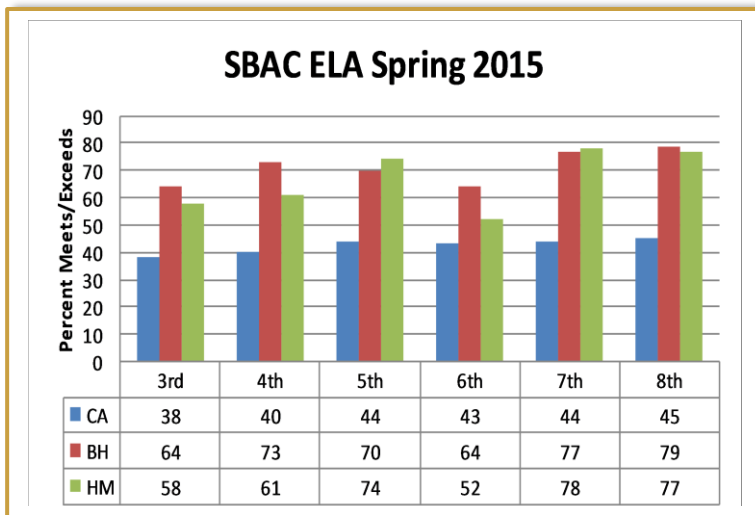

#### ELA scores:

Both 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade students scored higher than the BHUSD average with 74% and 78% of students meeting/exceeding standards respectively.

Both 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students had more than 70% of students meeting/exceeding standards.
